<u>Why?</u> This program is designed to recognize well rounded chapters who contribute to the State Program of Work! They must take part in member development, community service, conferences, leadership activities, national programs, and competitive events.

How? In order to be recognized with this award, chapters must complete all of the required elements <u>as well as</u> 20 out of 53 points of the Additional Point Options. The point values are in red next to the description below. An official application form must be filled out to give proof of completion.

<u>When?</u> Applications are due on March 1st and chapters will be recognized at the SLC during the Recognition Dinner when their chapter presidents go on stage to receive the award.

Requirements:

- Membership increase (at least 5 members) or maximum class membership
- Chapter attendance at Leadership Bootcamp (at least 4 members and 1 adviser)
- Significant participation in the FLC community service projects (exceeding the suggested minimum)
- Compete in competitive events at the SLC (at least 5 members competing)
- Complete Power of One (at least 3 members)
- Compete in 2 Fall Competitive Events

Additional Point Options: (must complete a minimum of 20 points)

Points Options (Show proof of each item with photos, screenshots, and documents, as applicable)

- Chapter representatives attendance at both pull out sessions at the FLC
- Submit an application for a State or National award for recognition
- Chapter participation in FCS Dine in Day, December 3rd (Show promotion and proof of participation)
- Chapter participation in Campaign for Tobacco Free Kids Program
- Meet with a superintendent or member of your town's school BOE to promote FCS and FCCLA
- Attendance by a minimum of 5 members at the 2019 FLC
- Make a chapter social media account and follow NJ FCCLA
- Create an FCCLA bulletin board at your school
 - Collaborate with another CTSO or business/industry partner
- Participate in the upcoming service initiative for the Leadership Bootcamp
- Make a chapter website and email the link to njfccla@gmail.com
- Competing in a STAR event at SLC
 - Participate in 3 of the FCCLA Week initiatives.
 - Attend the National Fall Conference (in Dallas, Texas)
 - Complete in a National Program (other than Power of One) and submit the application on fcclainc.org
- Apply for Go For the Red Membership Campaign (fcclainc.org)
- Chapter attendance at the 2019 NLC (at least 2 members and 1 adviser)
- Mentor a new chapter (proof of at least 3 supportive initiatives)
- Meet with a member of NJ legislature to advocate for FCCLA and FCS
