# Tuition / Absence & Makeup / Late Pickup / In-Class Behavioral Policy

## TUITION

Classes are paid on a monthly or 3-month basis, due the last class of each month (or term) to secure your seat for the next month. New students starting mid-month will pay \$45 per class for the remaining of the first month. There is no refund or credit for any classes missed. \*See the "MAKE UP POLICY" below.

## LATE FEES.

\$10 late fee will be charged if the tuition is not by the 2<sup>nd</sup> class of the month (or term). We reserve the right to dismiss any student whose tuition account is outstanding.

#### **ABSENCES & MAKE-UPS**

Make-up classes are given as a courtesy if the studio is notified in <u>WRITING</u> (email or text) a minimum of <u>24 hours in advance</u> of the absence or rescheduling. <u>No show or late notice receives NO makeup</u>. Make-up can be completed in an alternate class of the week or students can catch up using the video recording of the project.

#### TERMINATION

If you decide not to continue with our classes, as a courtesy, please send a written notification (email or text) at least two weeks prior to the end of the term so that we can schedule other students. The opportunity to make-up the absence is lost after the enrollment expires.

## LATE PICKUP (in-Person Class)

Students must be picked up ON TIME after class. There is a <u>\$10 late pickup charge</u> every 15-min block once exceeding the first 15-minute grace period.

## **BEHAVIOR POLICY**

Our studio is built on mutual respect for all parties involved (students, parents, and teachers.) In the rare case that a student exhibits difficulty or disruptive behavior in the class, the parent will be notified. We will attempt to resolve the challenge through a friendly dialogue. If a resolution cannot be reached, it may be deemed that our program is not a suitable learning environment for a student.

To foster an environment of independence for students, parents are to leave the studio when the instruction begins. Exceptions will be applied to students with special needs (or IEP) who require a "shadow".
