

Latest Guidance for Communal Worship from Bishop Richard

In a recent letter from Bishop Richard sent to parish priests and deacons, he clarifies the continued precautions that we need to take. Bishop Richard hopes that it will be possible to share good news before too long. In the meantime we should continue to implement the following precautions:-

Hymn books and Mass books continue not to be in use.

<u>Holy Communion</u> is distributed under one kind only – it is now permitted to announce "The Body of Christ" for each communicant, who may respond "Amen".

The physical exchange of the Sign of Peace remains suspended.

The <u>offertory basket</u> continues to be positioned where parishioners can make their offering on arriving at or leaving church.

Doors and windows should be opened to provide ventilation.

The church should be cleaned after services with frequent touchpoints requiring more regular cleaning. Hand sanitising should be available to those entering or leaving the church.

<u>Individuals or bubbles/households</u> should be seated at a social distance of 2m (or 1m with face coverings) from other groups or individuals.
