Pope Francis on All Saints/All Souls day:

There is a mysterious solidarity between those who have already passed to the other life and we pilgrims in this one. Our deceased loved ones continue to take care of us from heaven. They pray for us, and we pray for them and we pray with them.

Also:

Did you know that you can get a plenary indulgence any day this November? It's true. The Vatican has decided to grant Catholics who visit a cemetery to pray for the dead on any day in the month of November a plenary indulgence.

Usually, the Catholic Church only grants this plenary indulgence for the souls in Purgatory to those who pray in a cemetery on November 1 to 8, which is the week of the Solemnity of All Souls' Day.

Last year, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Apostolic Penitentiary issued a decree that extended the availability of some plenary indulgences because of concerns about avoiding large gatherings of people in churches or cemeteries. The Vatican has issued the same decree this year during the month of November.

The specific November 2 plenary indulgence one can receive for their own soul by visiting a church or an oratory and reciting an Our Father and the Creed, can now also be done on any day in November.

Terms and conditions apply - but don't let that discourage you.
