* Help Christians in Syria and Lebanon



Aid to the Church in Need's 2022 Christmas campaign focuses on Christian communities in two devastated Middle Eastern countries: Syria and Lebanon. In Syria, the United Nations (UN) considers that 90% of the population is living below the poverty line. Pope Francis has called the situation a "scandal" in this country still torn apart by the effects of the war that began in 2011 and which

is, despite the return of a certain normality (depending on the region), still at risk of erupting once again. Of the country's 23 million inhabitants in 2011, half have fled their homes: 5.5 million are refugees in the region while 6.7 million are internally displaced. In Canada, 60,000 families have been welcomed so far. Since 2011, ACN has supported projects in Syria, mostly in emergency aid (1118), for a total of 75 million dollars.

In Lebanon, misery is taking hold in what was once considered the Switzerland of the Middle East. The World Bank estimates that the financial collapse seen since 2019 is only matched by that of the mid-nineteenth century. More than 70% of the population currently lives below the poverty line. The economic crisis, largely caused by inaction on the part of the government, has been exacerbated by the COVID-19 pandemic as well as the August 4, 2020 explosion at the Port of Beirut. Christians were particularly hard hit, with one of their main neighbourhoods located just one kilometre from the blast. Aid to the Church in Need invites you to be generous. On behalf of those in need in Syria and Lebanon, we extend a warm thank you, or as they say, **Shukran!** In both countries, the support consists of housing assistance, the distribution of basic supplies, including food, the purchase of medicine, and pastoral assistance through the organization of youth camps, amongst others.
