Jesus created substance out of nothing (ex nihilo) because He is God.

No angel or creature can create any substance from nothing.

Jesus made wine from water. Water contains two kinds of atoms, hydrogen and oxygen only. Wine contains three kinds of atoms, carbon, hydrogen and oxygen plus other atoms such as sulfur, phosphorus, nitrogen.

The water they placed in the pots was purification water which means PURE water with no contamination.

Jesus created wine from nothing. He is God.

- **♣** John 2:6-10
- 6 Now there were set there six water pots of stone, according to the manner of purification of the Jews, containing twenty or thirty gallons apiece.
- 7 Jesus said to them, "Fill the water pots with water." And they filled them up to the brim.

- 8 And He said to them, "Draw some out now, and take it to the master of the feast." And they took it.
- 9 When the master of the feast had tasted the water that was made wine, and did not know where it came from (but the servants who had drawn the water knew), the master of the feast called the bridegroom.
- 10 And he said to him, "Every man at the beginning sets out the good wine, and when the guests have well drunk, then the inferior. You have kept the good wine until now!"

♦ Evidence 2 ♦

Jesus is God because He spoke the Word of healing from a great distance and His Creative Word brought healing.

- **♣ Matthew 8:8**
- 8 The centurion answered and said, "Lord, I am not worthy that You should come under my roof. But only speak a word, and my servant will be healed.

♦ Evidence 3 ♦

Jesus is God because of His creation of bread and fish to feed five thousands men plus women and children. This is a real creation.

♣ Mark 8:19

19 When I broke the five loaves for the five thousand, how many baskets full of fragments did you take up?" They said to Him, "Twelve."

Mark 6:41-44

- 41 And when He had taken the five loaves and the two fish, He looked up to heaven, blessed and broke the loaves, and gave them to His disciples to set before them; and the two fish. He divided among them all.
- 42 So they all ate and were filled.
- 43 And they took up twelve baskets full of fragments and of the fish.
- 44 Now those who had eaten the loaves were about five thousand men.

♦ Evidence 4 ♦

Jesus is God because He created the eyes of the man born blind. He created them from nothing because since his birth, he had no eyes, no optical nerve and no brain neurons in the brain connecting to the eyes vision and movement.

♣ John 9:1

1 Now as Jesus passed by, He saw a man who was blind from birth.

♣ John 9:6-10

- 6 When He had said these things, He spat on the ground and made clay with the saliva; and He anointed the eyes of the blind man with the clay.
- 7 And He said to him, "Go, wash in the pool of Siloam" (which is translated, Sent). So he went and washed, and came back seeing.
- 8 Therefore the neighbors and those who previously had seen that he was blind said, "Is not this he who sat and begged?"
- 9 Some said, "This is he." Others said, "He is like him." He said, "I am he."
- 10 Therefore they said to him, "How were your eyes opened?"

♦ Evidence 5 ♦

Jesus is God because He raises the dead to life. Other prophet ask God to raise someone from the dead. Jesus raised Lazarus and many others by His Creative Word.

(By the way, Jesus expressed emotions because He was incarnate as a true man and not a fake image of a man. This is why He is called the Son of Man.)

♣ John 11:32-43

- 32 Then, when Mary came where Jesus was, and saw Him, she fell down at His feet, saying to Him, "Lord, if You had been here, my brother would not have died."
- 33 Therefore, when Jesus saw her weeping, and the Jews who came with her weeping, He groaned in the spirit and was troubled.
- 34 And He said, "Where have you laid him?" They said to Him, "Lord, come and see." 35 Jesus wept.
- 36 Then the Jews said, "See how He loved him!"
- 37 And some of them said, "Could not this Man, who opened the eyes of the blind, also have kept this man from dying?"

- 38 Then Jesus, again groaning in Himself, came to the tomb. It was a cave, and a stone lay against it.
- 39 Jesus said, "Take away the stone."
 Martha, the sister of him who was dead, said to Him, "Lord, by this time there is a stench, for he has been dead four days."
- 40 Jesus said to her, "Did I not say to you that if you would believe you would see the glory of God?"
- 41 Then they took away the stone from the place where the dead man was lying. And Jesus lifted up His eyes and said, "Father, I thank You that You have heard Me.
- 42 And I know that You always hear Me, but because of the people who are standing by I said this, that they may believe that You sent Me."
- 43 Now when He had said these things, He cried with a loud voice, "Lazarus, come forth!"

Jesus is declared to be God according to Paul

Jesus is being in the "Form of God" means being God.

Jesus is being "Equal to God" means being God.

Notice that Jesus the incarnate human flesh is glorified because of His humility and obedience. Therefore, the human flesh of Jesus is raised above the angels and above all creatures.

- ♣ Philippians 2:5-11
- 5 Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus,
- 6 who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God,
- 7 but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men.
- 8 And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.
- 9 Therefore God also has highly exalted Him

and given Him the name which is above every name,

10 that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, 11 and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Jesus is God because He alone receives worship from all creatures.

Jesus is to receive the worship of all creatures. This means He is God because God said that "you shall not worship any other except God.

God swore that no creature can receive worship except God alone.

- ♣ Philippians 2:10-11 "That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth,
- 11 and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father."
- ♣ Isaiah 45:23
- 23 I have sworn by Myself; The word has gone out of My mouth in righteousness, and shall not return, That to Me every knee shall bow, Every tongue shall take an oath.

♦ Evidence 8 ♦

The Savior (the Messiah) cannot be a human or an angel. Jesus the Son of Man was the very person of God incarnate as the Son of Man.

Being God, Jesus is the Savior. Jesus is God and Man at the same time.

Isaiah 45:21-22

21 Tell and bring forth your case; Yes, let them take counsel together. Who has declared this from ancient time? Who has told it from that time? Have not I, the LORD? And there is no other God besides Me, A just God and a Savior; There is none besides Me.

22 "Look to Me, and be saved, All you ends of the earth! For I am God, and there is no other.

Acts 4:12

12 Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved."

♣ Isaiah 45:17

17 But Israel shall be saved by the LORD With an everlasting salvation; You shall not be

ashamed or disgraced forever and ever.

- **♣** Isaiah 44:6
- 6 "Thus says the LORD, the King of Israel, and his Redeemer, the LORD of hosts: 'I am the First and I am the Last; Besides Me there is no God.

Paul is affirming that Jesus is God as One LORD as God is One God. He is comparing Jesus to all the other lords

He is comparing Jesus to all the other lords and gods and Paul is saying that Jesus is God and the only LORD.

- # 1 Corinthians 8:5-6
- 5 For even if there are so-called gods, whether in heaven or on earth (as there are many gods and many lords),
- 6 yet for us there is one God, the Father, of whom are all things, and we for Him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, through whom are all things, and through whom we live.

Only God the Creator controls the existence, the movement and the lives of every creature. Jesus is God and Paul is affirming that Jesus is the Creator who is sovereign and in whom we exist and live.

1 Corinthians 8:6

6 Yet for us there is one God, the Father, of whom are all things, and we for Him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, through whom are all things, and through whom we live.

God declared the birth of Jesus and declared that this Jesus is the very person of the Mighty God.

♣ Isaiah 9:6

6 For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

♣ Luke 1:35

35 And the angel answered and said to her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Highest will overshadow you; therefore, also, that Holy One who is to be born will be called the Son of God. (The term Son of God means God of God. God is One and He has no division or parts.)

God declared that Jesus' name means "God with Us."

The term Immanuel means: 'Immanu = with us and EI = God.

♣ Isaiah 7:14

14 Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and shall call His name Immanuel.

Jesus is God because Jeremiah called Him the personal name of God, i.e., YHWH which no one can have except God alone.

♣ Jeremiah 23:6

6 In His days Judah will be saved, and Israel will dwell safely; Now this is His name by which He will be called: THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS (read in Hebrew: He will be called: YHWH Tsedekenu).

Jesus is God declared as Son of God (God of God).

- Proverbs 30:4
- 4 Who has ascended into heaven, or descended? Who has gathered the wind in His fists? Who has bound the waters in a garment? Who has established all the ends of the earth? What is His name, and what is His Son's name, If you know?
- **♣ John 20:30-31**
- 30 And truly Jesus did many other signs in the presence of His disciples, which are not written in this book;
- 31 but these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name.

God is declared to be ascended into heaven and descended. Jesus is God declared the same by Paul.

- ♣ Ephesians 4:8-10
- 8 Therefore He says: "When He ascended on high, He led captivity captive, and gave gifts to men."
- 9 (Now this, "He ascended"--what does it mean but that He also first descended into the lower parts of the earth?
- 10 He who descended is also the One who ascended far above all the heavens, that He might fill all things.)
- Proverbs 30:4
- 4 Who has ascended into heaven, or descended? Who has gathered the wind in His fists? Who has bound the waters in a garment? Who has established all the ends of the earth? What is His name, and what is His Son's name, If you know?

Jesus is God because Jesus is the Creator of the world and everything in it.

The creation was made by the Word of God, Genesis 1:3, 6, 9, 11, 14 ...etc.

- ♣ Psalm 33:6
- 6 By the Word of the LORD the heavens were made, and all the host of them by the breath of His mouth.

Jesus is the Creator and He is the Word who created the universe.

- **♣** John 1:1-3
- 1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
- 2 He was in the beginning with God.
- 3 All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made.

Jesus is the Creator God. He created the world. He created the Free Will of men and angels and they rebelled against Him.

⊕ John 1:10

10 He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, and the world did not know Him.

Jesus is God who created everything.

⊕ Colossians 1:16

16 For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him.

♦ Evidence 19 ♦

Jesus is God because He is eternal before anything in the world was created because He was the Creator.

♣ Colossians 1:1717 And He is before all things, and in Him all things consist.

Jesus is God, the Creator of all things.

- **♣** Ephesians 3:9
- 9 and to make all see what is the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the ages has been hidden in God who created all things through Jesus Christ.

Jesus is the Creator God.

- **#** Hebrews 1:1-2
- 1 God, who at various times and in various ways spoke in time past to the fathers by the prophets,
- 2 has in these last days spoken to us by His Son, whom He has appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the worlds;

Jesus is called God in the Book of Hebrews. The term "companions" refers to co-workers whether angels or humans, but it does not refer to coequals.

- **#** Hebrews 1:8-9
- 8 But to the Son He says: "Your throne, O God, is forever and ever; A scepter of righteousness is the scepter of Your Kingdom.
- 9 You have loved righteousness and hated lawlessness; Therefore God, Your God, has anointed You With the oil of gladness more than Your companions."

Jesus is God the Creator of all things.

- **♣** Hebrews 1:10-12
- 10 And: "You, LORD, in the beginning laid the foundation of the earth, and the heavens are the work of Your hands.
- 11 They will perish, but You remain; And they will all grow old like a garment;
- 12 Like a cloak You will fold them up, and they will be changed. But You are the same, and Your years will not fail."

Jesus is the Creator God, the one who began all the creation.

♣ Revelation 3:14

14 "And to the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write, 'These things says the Amen, the Faithful and True Witness, the Beginning of the creation of God:

Jesus is the very person of God. He is the only person who knows and sees God in His full glory. No creature can see God as He is. Jesus is God incarnate in human flesh. When we see Jesus, we see God truly. Remember that Jesus left His glory and became a humble man like us to allow us to see Him.

- **Exodus 33:20**
- 20 But He said, "You cannot see My face; for no man shall see Me, and live."
- # 1 John 4:12
- 12 No one has seen God at any time. If we love one another, God abides in us, and His love has been perfected in us.
- **♣** John 1:18
- 18 No one has seen God at any time. The only begotten Son, who is in the bosom of the Father, He has declared Him. (Some prophets saw glimpses of God, but never God as He is.)

Jesus testified that He is God and He and Abba Father are One God. He is in the Father. The Father is in Him. God is One without separation.

- # John 14:8-11
- 8 Philip said to Him, "Lord, show us the Father, and it is sufficient for us."
- 9 Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; so how can you say, 'Show us the Father'?
- 10 Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? The words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own authority; but the Father who dwells in Me does the works.
- 11 Believe Me that I am in the Father and the Father in Me, or else believe Me for the sake of the works themselves.

John the Baptist testified that Jesus is God and he is unworthy to carry his sandals. He knew that Jesus though a human yet is the person of God. He was God incarnate. Humans baptize with water, but Jesus who is God baptizes with the Holy Spirit who is the very person of God and fire which represents the purification of God in our souls and hearts.

Matthew 3:11

11 I (John the Baptizer) indeed baptize you with water unto repentance, but He who is coming after me is mightier than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire.

Paul testified that Jesus is the very person of God, having not the persona only but the nature, i.e., the form of God. He is God incarnate in the flesh. This concept causes confusion with many **Christians and Jews for three reasons: (1)** Paganism is common in the Church theology. Many pastors understand falsely that God was like Zeus having metamorphosed into man. This is a heinous heresy, yet believed by many Christians. (2) Many Jews and Christians follow and believe in Spiritism and Kabbalism thus they misinterpret this verse. (3) Intellectualism tries to understand: "How on earth can God be incarnate as a man?" and Christian Intellectualism fails miserably because God is above and beyond their understanding.

This is a mystery and it is impossible for humans or angels to understand it.

- + Philippians 2:5-8
- 5 Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus.
- 6 who, being in the form of God, did not

consider it robbery to be equal with God, 7 but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men.

8 And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.

Jesus is God. The Greek translators and many pastors erroneously said that He was arisen from the dead. Actually, the correct translation is that He rose from the dead (by His own power).

God does not die. God did not die. God will not die. Jesus who is the incarnate humanity of God died on the Cross. Jesus who is God (incarnate) rose from the dead by Himself. He was not made to rise, but He rose from the dead by His own power.

The Greek language uses a "deponent verb" to rise (érgomaï) and the translated assumed falsely that this means a passive voice rather than active voice. The translators erred. Deponent verbs are active voice, although in their conjugation they assume a reflexive action, but not necessarily passive action. In English, this is similar to transitive with self as object and intransitive verbs with no object.

♣ Luke 24:6

6 He is not here, but is risen! (Should be rose from the dead). Remember how He spoke to

you when He was still in Galilee,

- **♣** Luke 24:34
- 34 saying, "The Lord is risen (Should be rose from the dead) indeed, and has appeared to Simon!"
- **Romans** 14:9
- 9 For to this end Christ died and rose and lived again, that He might be Lord of both the dead and the living.

Jesus is God because He is eternal. He was before He created the "TIME Lattice" and He will be after the "Time" ends.

♣ Micah 5:2

2 "But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, Though you are little among the thousands of Judah, Yet out of you shall come forth to Me The One to be Ruler in Israel, Whose goings forth are from of old, From everlasting."

Jesus testified that He is God and the Glory of God is His own Glory from before the creation of anything and even eternally. Jesus is the very person of God.

♣ John 17:5

5 Now, O Father, glorify Me together with Yourself, with the glory which I had with You before the world was.

Jesus is the very person of God. He is called the Word because His Word created all the creation.

⊕ John 1:1

1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

Jesus the Son of God is the very person of God as testified in the Book of Hebrews.

- ♣ Hebrews 1:8-12
- 8 But to the Son He says: "Your throne, O God, is forever and ever; A scepter of righteousness is the scepter of Your Kingdom.
- 9 You have loved righteousness and hated lawlessness; Therefore God, Your God, has anointed You With the oil of gladness more than Your companions."
- 10 And: "You, LORD, in the beginning laid the foundation of the earth, and the heavens are the work of Your hands.
- 11 They will perish, but You remain; And they will all grow old like a garment;
- 12 Like a cloak You will fold them up, and they will be changed. But You are the same, and Your years will not fail."

♦ Evidence 34 ♦

Thomas declared the Jesus is the very person of God. And Jesus approved his testimony.

♣ John 20:2828 And Thomas answered and said to Him,*My Lord and my God!**

Jesus is God. His image is the image of God and His form is the form of God incarnate in humanity.

- **♣** John 14:8-9
- 8 Philip said to Him, "Lord, show us the Father, and it is sufficient for us."
- 9 Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; so how can you say, 'Show us the Father'?
- ♣ Colossians 1:15
- 15 He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation.

Jesus testified that He is One with the Father God. There is One God who revealed Himself as Triune in nature (not three persons, but one person and One God).

John 10:3030 I and My Father are one."

Jesus is fully God. He is the very person of God.

- + Colossians 2:9
- 9 For in Him dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily.

♦ Evidence 38 ♦

Jesus is eternal because He is God who is eternal. No creature is eternal, but God is and was and shall be, hence His personal name YHWH which means exactly that.

♣ John 8:58
58 Jesus said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, before Abraham was, I AM."

Jesus said that His real Name is YHWH expressed in the "I AM".

When Moses asked God about his personal name, because Egypt had hundreds of gods. God answered him and told him my name is "I AM." This is exactly what Jesus said as His own personal name. The name "I AM" and "YHWH" are the same.

The Jews understood what Jesus said that He is the very person of God, hence they accused Him of blasphemy and attempted to kill him at that moment.

♣ John 8:58

58 Jesus said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, before Abraham was, I AM."

♣ Exodus 3:14

14 And God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM." And He said, "Thus you shall say to the children of Israel, 'I AM has sent me to you.' "

Jesus is the very person of God who carries the personal name of God, i.e. YHWH. The name YHWH is a conjunction of two verbs, the first YHYH which means He who exists now and forever, and the verb HAWA (HAVA) which means He who was from eternity.

Thus the name YHWH is the unique personal name of God just as the name "I AM". Jesus declared in the book of Revelation declares that Jesus is YHWH God.

♣ Revelation 1:8

8 "I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End," says the Lord, "who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty."

Jesus the Messiah Savior is the very person of God.

- **⊕** Isaiah 44:6
- 6 "Thus says the LORD, the King of Israel, and his Redeemer, the LORD of hosts: 'I am the First and I am the Last; Besides Me there is no God.
- ♣ Isaiah 48:12
- 12 "Listen to Me, O Jacob, and Israel, My called: I am He, I am the First, I am also the Last.

Jesus is the Son of God which means He is God of God. The Jews understood the meaning. But, the pagan Christians today believe that Son of God is similar to Hercules who was the son of Zeus after he seduced a human woman.

The term Son of God means the very person of God.

Adam and the true born again believers are called sons of God, or children of God by adoption. This does not mean that they become God or become divine as God in any way. It is a legal term of adoption.

But with Jesus, the term Son of God is unique meaning God of God. Jesus is "the unique One, who is Himself God" (Greek: monogenes theos).1:18

♣ John 1:18

18 No one has seen God at any time. The only begotten Son, who is in the bosom of the Father, He has declared Him.

₽ John 1:49

49 Nathanael answered and said to Him, "Rabbi, You are the Son of God! You are the King of Israel!"

♣ John 11:27

27 She said to Him, "Yes, Lord, I believe that You are the Christ, the Son of God, who is to come into the world."

♣ John 5:18

18 Therefore the Jews sought all the more to kill Him, because He not only broke the Sabbath, but also said that God was His Father, making Himself equal with God.

Jesus testified that He is God who gives life. No prophet could claim that he brings life.

- **♣ John 6:48-51**
- 48 I am the bread of life.
- 49 Your fathers ate the manna in the wilderness, and are dead.
- 50 This is the bread which comes down from heaven, that one may eat of it and not die.
- 51 I am the living bread which came down from heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever; and the bread that I shall give is My flesh, which I shall give for the life of the world."

God the Father testified that Jesus is the Son of God.

♣ John 8:18

18 I am One who bears witness of Myself, and the Father who sent Me bears witness of Me."

Matthew 17:4-6

- 4 Then Peter answered and said to Jesus, "Lord, it is good for us to be here; if You wish, let us make here three tabernacles: one for You, one for Moses, and one for Elijah."
 5 While he was still speaking, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them; and suddenly a voice came out of the cloud, saying, "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased. Hear Him!"
- 6 And when the disciples heard it, they fell on their faces and were greatly afraid.

♣ Matthew 3:16-17

16 When He had been baptized, Jesus came up immediately from the water; and behold, the heavens were opened to Him, and He saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting upon Him.

17 And suddenly a voice came from heaven, saying, "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased."

Jesus testified that He is the very person of God who is the Shepherd (the Good Shepherd) of his people, the believers Israel.

♣ John 10:14-15

14 I am the Good Shepherd; and I know My sheep, and am known by My own.

15 As the Father knows Me, even so I know the Father; and I lay down My life for the sheep.

Jesus testified that He is God, the Door to life and redemption.

No prophet can claim the he is the Door to salvation. But, Jesus who is the very person of God is the only Door to enter into life and redemption from our sins.

- **♣** John 10:7-9
- 7 Then Jesus said to them again, "Most assuredly, I say to you, I am the door of the sheep.
- 8 All who ever came before Me are thieves and robbers, but the sheep did not hear them.
- 9 I am the door. If anyone enters by Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture.

Jesus testified that he who sees Him, sees God who sent Him. The expression "who sent me" does not mean a hierarchy or division, but the counsel of God in His Triune nature ordained God the Son to be incarnate in humanity to preach and to die for the redemption of mankind, those who believe.

♣ John 12:44-45

44 Then Jesus cried out and said, "He who believes in Me, believes not in Me but in Him who sent Me.

45 And he who sees Me sees Him who sent Me.

Jesus describe Himself as God who brought light on Day One of the creation. In the Hebrew language, the word light on Day One is "m'or" while the word light in general is "or."

Jesus described Himself as the Light "m'or" whose origin is divine, i.e., the person of God. Jesus is the very person of God.

♣ John 12:44-46

44 Then Jesus cried out and said, "He who believes in Me, believes not in Me but in Him who sent Me.

45 And he who sees Me sees Him who sent Me.

46 I have come as light into the world, that whoever believes in Me should not abide in darkness.

♣ John 8:12

12 Then Jesus spoke to them again, saying, "I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life."

Jesus testified that He is the Father and as incarnate in humanity, He is the Way to God. No other prophet has or can give us access to the person of God, except God incarnate, Jesus.

♣ John 14:6

6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.

Jesus is the Truth. The Truth can only come from God. Jesus is the Truth because He is God.

♣ John 14:6

6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.

Jesus is God who alone is the life giver.

₽ John 14:6

6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.

♣ John 10:10

10 The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.

Jesus testified that He is the very person of God. He does by nature what God does. Even, in His incarnate human body, he keeps His body obedient to His Divine nature.

♣ John 8:28-29

28 Then Jesus said to them, "When you lift up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am He, and that I do nothing of Myself; but as My Father taught Me, I speak these things.
29 And He who sent Me is with Me. The Father has not left Me alone, for I always do those things that please Him."

Jesus testified that He and the Holy Spirit are equal. The Greek word of "another Helper" is actually "another same Helper."

The Holy Spirit was not different from Jesus because God is Abba Father, Son of God and Holy Spirit One person.

♣ John 14:16

16 And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another (similar to me) Helper, that He may abide with you forever.

Jesus is the Creator not only of mankind, but also of angels and all objects in the entire universe.

Not only did Jesus the Son of God created all things, but also all things are for Him. Jesus is God.

- **♣** Colossians 1:14-17
- 14 in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins.
- 15 He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation.
- 16 For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him.
- 17 And He is before all things, and in Him all things consist.

The works of Jesus testify to His divinity.

♣ John 5:34-37

34 Yet I do not receive testimony from man, but I say these things that you may be saved. 35 He was the burning and shining lamp, and you were willing for a time to rejoice in his light.

36 But I have a greater witness than John's; for the works which the Father has given Me to finish--the very works that I do--bear witness of Me, that the Father has sent Me. 37 And the Father Himself, who sent Me, has testified of Me. You have neither heard His voice at any time, nor seen His form.

Abba Father testifies for Himself, the Son of God incarnate Jesus.

♣ John 5:36-37

36 But I have a greater witness than John's; for the works which the Father has given Me to finish--the very works that I do--bear witness of Me, that the Father has sent Me. 37 And the Father Himself, who sent Me, has testified of Me. You have neither heard His voice at any time, nor seen His form.

The Jews (Pharisees rabbis, Sadducees, and Scribes) understood Jesus testimony of Himself that He is God.

♣ John 10:33

33 The Jews answered Him, saying, "For a good work we do not stone You, but for blasphemy, and because You, being a Man, make Yourself God."

♦ Evidence 58 ♦

Paul testifies that Jesus is fully God although He was incarnate in humanity.

♣ Colossians 1:19 For in him all the fulness of God was pleased to dwell,

Jesus is the Creator and the Beginner of all creation.

The Greek translators used the term "firstborn" which led some Christian pagans to assume that Jesus was created. The Greek term "prototokos" which is translated as "firstborn" does NOT mean "first created." Rather, Paul uses a term that was based on the ancient designation of the authority, or pre-eminence, metaphorically given to first who begins the family (Genesis. 49:3–4; Exodus 4:22).

A better translation of this term here should be "Beginner of all creation" or "First leader or highest officer of all creation."

In the same way, David, the youngest of Jesse, was named "firstborn" (Psalm 89:20–27) because he brought his family into royalty over Israel. Also, although Manasseh was born to Joseph first, but Ephraim, his younger brother, was "firstborn" due to his position as given by Jacob's blessing (Genesis 48:13–20, Jeremiah 31:9).

- 16 For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him.

Jesus self existed because He is God the Creator of whom all things exist and subsist.

- 16 For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him.

- 18 And He is the head of the body, the church, who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in all things He may have the preeminence.

Jesus is fully God in nature and He reflected God's character in His incarnate humanity.

- ♣ Hebrews 1:3
- 3 who being the brightness of His glory (God's glory) and the express image of His person, and upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins, sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high.

Jesus is God, divine in power and He is our Savior because only God can save us.

- # 2 Peter 1:2-4
- 2 Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord, 3 as His divine power has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue,
- 4 by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

Paul testified that Jesus is God.

♣ Titus 2:13

13 looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ,

Jesus the Son of God is God eternal.

♣ Hebrews 1:8 But of the Son he says, "Your throne, O God, is for ever and ever, the righteous scepter is the scepter of thy kingdom."

God the Father calls Jesus His Son "God." God is One Triune in nature.

- ♣ Psalm 45:6-7
- 6 Your throne, O God, is forever and ever; A scepter of righteousness is the scepter of Your kingdom.
- 7 You love righteousness and hate wickedness; Therefore God, Your God, has anointed You With the oil of gladness more than Your companions.

Jesus is worshiped as God. By Thomas, the angels, wise men, a leper, a ruler, a blind man, women, Mary Magdalena, and the disciples.

- ♣ John 20:28 "And Thomas answered and said to Him, "My Lord and my God!"
- ♣ Hebrews 1:6 "But when He again brings the firstborn into the world, He says: "Let all the angels of God worship Him."
- ♣ Matthew 2:11 "And when they had come into the house, they saw the young Child with Mary His mother, and fell down and worshiped Him. And when they had opened their treasures, they presented gifts to Him: gold, frankincense, and myrrh."
- ♣ Matthew 8:2 "And behold, a leper came and worshiped Him, saying, "Lord, if You are willing, You can make me clean."
- ♣ Matthew 9:18 "While He spoke these things to them, behold, a ruler came and worshiped Him, saying, "My daughter has just died, but

come and lay Your hand on her and she will live."

- ♣ John 9:38 "Then he said, "Lord, I believe!" And he worshiped Him."
- ♣ Matthew 15:25 "Then she came and worshiped Him, saying, "Lord, help me!"

Jesus is worshiped and will be worshiped by all creatures while it is forbidden by God to worship anyone but God. Jesus is God.

- **⊕** Exodus 20:1-5

those who hate Me.

- 1 And God spoke all these words, saying:

Jesus accepted to be worshiped and be called Son of God (which means God of God).

Jesus will receive honor equal to God the Father because God is One and Jesus is God, the Son.

23 that all should honor the Son just as they honor the Father. He who does not honor the Son does not honor the Father who sent Him.

8 Now when He had taken the scroll, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb, each having a harp, and golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the saints.

In the following verses we see God the Father as equal to God the Son though they have different role in the redemption of mankind. It is clear that Jesus is God the Redeemer and at His Second Coming, He will be the Judge.

Jesus is omnipotent (possesses all power) because He is God.

♣ Philippians 3:20-21

20 For our citizenship is in heaven, from which we also eagerly wait for the Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ.

21 who will transform our lowly body that it may be conformed to His glorious body, according to the working by which He is able even to subdue all things to Himself.

1 Peter 3:22

22 who has gone into heaven and is at the right hand of God, angels and authorities and powers having been made subject to Him.

♣ Revelation 19:16

16 And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.

Jesus is omniscient (all-knowing) because He is God.

- Colossians 2:2-3
- 2 that their hearts may be encouraged, being knit together in love, and attaining to all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the knowledge of the mystery of God, both of the Father and of Christ,
- 3 in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.

Some churches teach that Jesus was not God because he said one time, that even the Son of Man does not know the hour of the Second Coming.

Jesus specified that in His human nature He was a weak person like all of us. He grew up as a child and learned the skills of life like all children. He gets sick if he catches the flu and he gets tired and emotional like all humans but without sin.

Jesus is both Son of Man and Son of God at the same time.

Jesus referred to the lack of knowledge and the limitation of the Son of Man. But, as the Son of God, Jesus is omniscient.

♣ Luke 5:4-6

- 4 When He had stopped speaking, He said to Simon, "Launch out into the deep and let down your nets for a catch."
- 5 But Simon answered and said to Him, "Master, we have toiled all night and caught nothing; nevertheless at Your word I will let down the net."
- 6 And when they had done this, they caught a great number of fish, and their net was breaking.

John 21:6-11

- 6 And He said to them, "Cast the net on the right side of the boat, and you will find some." So they cast, and now they were not able to draw it in because of the multitude of fish.
- 7 Therefore that disciple whom Jesus loved said to Peter, "It is the Lord!" Now when Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he put on his outer garment (for he had removed it), and plunged into the sea.
- 8 But the other disciples came in the little boat (for they were not far from land, but

about two hundred cubits), dragging the net with fish.

- 10 Jesus said to them, "Bring some of the fish which you have just caught."

Jesus is God because He know God intimately where no other creature knows. Jesus and God are One and the same.

27 All things have been delivered to Me by My Father, and no one knows the Son except the Father. Nor does anyone know the Father except the Son, and the one to whom the Son wills to reveal Him.

♣ John 7:29

29 But I know Him, for I am from Him, and He sent Me."

♣ John 8:55

55 Yet you have not known Him, but I know Him. And if I say, 'I do not know Him,' I shall be a liar like you; but I do know Him and keep His word.

♣ John 10:15

15 As the Father knows Me, even so I know the Father; and I lay down My life for the sheep.

A most beautiful and revealing prayer between Jesus the Son of Man and God the Father is found in John chapter 17.

- 1 Jesus spoke these words, lifted up His eyes to heaven, and said: "Father, the hour has come. Glorify Your Son, that Your Son also may glorify You,
- 2 as You have given Him authority over all flesh, that He should give eternal life to as many as You have given Him.
- 3 And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.
- 4 I have glorified You on the earth. I have finished the work which You have given Me to do.
- 5 And now, O Father, glorify Me together with Yourself, with the glory which I had with You before the world was.
- 6 "I have manifested Your name to the men whom You have given Me out of the world. They were Yours, You gave them to Me, and they have kept Your word.
- 7 Now they have known that all things which

- 15 I do not pray that You should take them

- out of the world, but that You should keep them from the evil one.
- 16 They are not of the world, just as I am not of the world.
- 17 Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth.
- 18 As You sent Me into the world, I also have sent them into the world.
- 19 And for their sakes I sanctify Myself, that they also may be sanctified by the truth.
- 20 "I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in Me through their word:
- 21 that they all may be one, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You sent Me.
- 22 And the glory which You gave Me I have given them, that they may be one just as We are one:
- 23 I in them, and You in Me; that they may be made perfect in one, and that the world may know that You have sent Me, and have loved them as You have loved Me.
- 24 Father, I desire that they also whom You gave Me may be with Me where I am, that they may behold My glory which You have given Me; for You loved Me before the foundation of

the world.

25 O righteous Father! The world has not known You, but I have known You; and these have known that You sent Me.

26 And I have declared to them Your name, and will declare it, that the love with which You loved Me may be in them, and I in them."

Jesus is God because He sits on the same throne as God the Father. He is One God Triune in nature.

- **♣ 1 Kings 22:19**
- 19 Then Micaiah said, "Therefore hear the word of the LORD: I saw the LORD sitting on His throne, and all the host of heaven standing by, on His right hand and on His left.
- **₽** Psalm 11:4
- 4 The LORD is in His holy temple, The LORD'S throne is in heaven; His eyes behold, His eyelids test the sons of men.
- **♣** Psalm 47:8
- 8 God reigns over the nations; God sits on His holy throne.
- ♣ Revelation 7:17
- 17 for the Lamb who is in the midst of the throne will shepherd them and lead them to living fountains of waters. And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes."

- + Colossians 3:11 "... Christ is all and in all."

Jesus is God because He is the First and the Last, the Alpha and the Omega, the Aleph and Tav. God the Father is the First and the Last. God is One.

♣ Isaiah 41:4

4 Who has performed and done it, Calling the generations from the beginning? 'I, the LORD, am the first; And with the last I am He.'

♣ Isaiah 48:12

12 "Listen to Me, O Jacob, and Israel, My called: I am He, I am the First, I am also the Last.

♣ Revelation 1:8

8 "I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End," says the Lord, "who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty."

♣ Revelation 1:11

11 saying, "I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last," and, "What you see, write in a book and send it to the seven

Jesus has the glory of God which no creature has. Jesus is God.

- 1 My brethren, do not hold the faith of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Lord of glory, with partiality.
- # 1 Corinthians 2:8
- 8 which none of the rulers of this age knew; for had they known, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.
- **♣ Psalm 24:7-8**
- 7 Lift up your heads, O you gates! And be lifted up, you everlasting doors! And the King of glory shall come in.
- 8 Who is this King of glory? The LORD strong and mighty, The LORD mighty in battle.

Jesus is God already. He was not elevated to a higher position with God. The term seated at the right hand means that God the Son will be the Judge of the world. God the Son, Jesus, will be at the forefront of God's final judgement.

₽ Psalm 110:1

1 The LORD said to my Lord, "Sit at My right hand, till I make Your enemies Your footstool."

Hebrews 12:2

2 looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

Acts 2:30

30 Therefore, being a prophet, and knowing that God had sworn with an oath to him that of the fruit of his body, according to the flesh, He would raise up the Christ to sit on his throne,

- 5 Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus,

Some sincere Christians and some pagan Christians misunderstand these verses assuming that Jesus was a creature who was elevated to God's level. This is the crux of Jehovah Witness and Mormonism which are false.

Jesus is God because He alone forgives sins. No one can forgive sins except God. God's forgiveness of the true (born again) believers is based on their faith and acceptance of Jesus as God LORD and Savior.

♣ Mark 2:5-12

- 5 When Jesus saw their faith, He said to the paralytic, "Son, your sins are forgiven you."
- 6 And some of the scribes were sitting there and reasoning in their hearts,

- 11 I say to you, arise, take up your bed, and go to your house."
- 12 Immediately he arose, took up the bed,

and went out in the presence of them all, so that all were amazed and glorified God, saying, "We never saw anything like this!"

♣ Matthew 9:2-7

- 2 Then behold, they brought to Him a paralytic lying on a bed. When Jesus saw their faith, He said to the paralytic, "Son, be of good cheer; your sins are forgiven you."
- 3 And at once some of the scribes said within themselves, "This Man blasphemes!"
- 4 But Jesus, knowing their thoughts, said, "Why do you think evil in your hearts?
- 5 For which is easier, to say, 'Your sins are forgiven you,' or to say, 'Arise and walk'?
- 6 But that you may know that the Son of Man has power on earth to forgive sins"--then He said to the paralytic, "Arise, take up your bed, and go to your house."
- 7 And he arose and departed to his house.

Luke 7:47-50

- 47 Therefore I say to you, her sins, which are many, are forgiven, for she loved much. But to whom little is forgiven, the same loves little."
- 48 Then He said to her, "Your sins are forgiven." 49 And those who sat at the table

with Him began to say to themselves, "Who is this who even forgives sins?" 50 Then He said to the woman, "Your faith has saved you. Go in peace."

Jesus testified for Himself saying that He is the Son of God, i.e., God of God.

Mark 14:60-62

60 And the high priest stood up in the midst and asked Jesus, saying, "Do You answer nothing? What is it these men testify against You?"

61 But He kept silent and answered nothing. Again the high priest asked Him, saying to Him, "Are You the Christ, the Son of the Blessed?"

62 Jesus said, "I am. And you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the Power, and coming with the clouds of heaven."

♣ Daniel 7:13-14

13 "I was watching in the night visions, and behold, One like the Son of Man, Coming with the clouds of heaven! He came to the Ancient of Days, and they brought Him near before Him.

14 Then to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, That all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, Which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one Which shall not be destroyed.

Jesus is God because prayers should be addressed to Jesus. No prayer should be addressed to other creatures living or dead, physical or spiritual. Only God receives our prayers.

John 14:13-14

13 And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.

14 If you ask anything in My name, I will do it.

John 16:26

26 In that day you will ask in My name, and I do not say to you that I shall pray the Father for you.

+ Acts 7:59

59 And they stoned Stephen as he was calling on God and saying, "Lord Jesus, receive my spirit."

♣ 1 Corinthians 1:2

2 To the church of God which is at Corinth, to those who are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints, with all who in every place call on the name of Jesus Christ our Lord, both theirs and ours:

♣ Joel 2:32

32 And it shall come to pass That whoever calls on the name of the LORD Shall be saved. For in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there shall be deliverance, As the LORD has said, Among the remnant whom the LORD calls.

The Kingdom of God is the Kingdom of Heaven. The Kingdom of Heaven is the Kingdom of Christ. Christ is God and He is the King of kings. No one can enter the Kingdom of Heaven except if he calls Him LORD God. Calling Jesus God LORD is not sufficient if the person does not believe. Many pastors and Bible preachers and Christians (90%) are not born again.

To enter into the Kingdom of Christ which is the Kingdom of Heaven, the person must be born again by Jesus the only Savior.

- **+** Romans 10:9
- 9 that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.
- ♣ Matthew 7:21
- 21 "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven.

- **Matthew 11:28**
- 28 Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

Jesus is God. No one has absolute full authority except God.

Matthew 28:18

18 And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth.

♣ Daniel 7:13-14

13 "I was watching in the night visions, and behold, One like the Son of Man, Coming with the clouds of heaven! He came to the Ancient of Days, and they brought Him near before Him.

14 Then to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, That all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, Which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one Which shall not be destroyed.

Jesus came and offered Himself as the Lamb of God to save all who believe on Him. He is coming again as the Judge because He is God. God is the only Judge.

1 Samuel 2:10

10 The adversaries of the LORD shall be broken in pieces; From heaven He will thunder against them. The LORD will judge the ends of the earth. "He will give strength to His king, and exalt the horn of His anointed."

₽ Psalm 50:6

6 Let the heavens declare His righteousness, For God Himself is Judge. Selah

₽ Psalm 2:1-9

- 1 Why do the nations rage, and the people plot a vain thing?
- 2 The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, Against the LORD and against His Anointed, saying,
- 3 "Let us break Their bonds in pieces And cast away Their cords from us."
- 4 He who sits in the heavens shall laugh; The LORD shall hold them in derision.

- 5 Then He shall speak to them in His wrath, and distress them in His deep displeasure:6 "Yet I have set My King On My holy hill of Zion."
- 7 "I will declare the decree: The LORD has said to Me, 'You are My Son, Today I have begotten You.
- 8 Ask of Me, and I will give You The nations for Your inheritance, and the ends of the earth for Your possession.
- 9 You shall break them with a rod of iron; You shall dash them to pieces like a potter's vessel.'

22 For the Father judges no one, but has committed all judgment to the Son,

♣ John 5:27

27 and has given Him authority to execute judgment also, because He is the Son of Man.

♣ John 9:39

39 And Jesus said, "For judgment I have come into this world, that those who do not see may see, and that those who see may be made blind."

Acts 10:42

42 And He commanded us to preach to the people, and to testify that it is He who was ordained by God to be Judge of the living and the dead.

♣ 2 Timothy 4:1

1 I charge you therefore before God and the Lord Jesus Christ, who will judge the living and the dead at His appearing and His kingdom:

Jesus is God. He never said, "Thus says the Lord" as did the prophets; He always said, "Verily, verily, I say unto you. . . ." And, His Word is absolute truth.

♣ Mark 13:31

31 Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will by no means pass away.

Jesus did many miracles by His direct Word. Some of Jesus' more notable miracles include turning water into wine (John 2:7–8); walking on the sea (Matthew 14:25; Mark 6:48; John 6:19); calming a stormy sea (Matthew 8:26; Mark 4:39; Luke 8:24); feeding 5,000 men and their families (Matthew 14:19; Mark 6:41; Luke 9:16; John 6:11); raising Lazarus from the dead (John 11:43–44); and causing the disciples to catch a great number of fish (Luke 5:5–6).

Jesus is God. Jesus is not a lesser God because God is One and there is no divisions in God.

♣ John 5:18

18 Therefore the Jews sought all the more to kill Him, because He not only broke the Sabbath, but also said that God was His Father, making Himself equal with God.

John 10:3030 I and My Father are one."

Jesus the Son of Man prayed to God. Jesus is God, but as the Son of Man he submitted his body and humanity in full obedience and fulfillment of the laws of God.

Some cults and false pastors (90% of Christians) claim that this is a sign of weakness or inferiority. No, the Son of Man was fully submissive to fulfill the law. All the while, Jesus was and remains the Son of God, i.e., God of God and One God.

Officially, Jesus prayed as a man, as a Jew, and as our High Priest to fulfill our redemption.

- Hebrews 2:17
- 17 Therefore, in all things He had to be made like His brethren, that He might be a merciful and faithful High Priest in things pertaining to God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people.
- Philippians 2:5-8Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus,

- 6 who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, 7 but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men.
- 8 And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.

Jesus is called the same names of God:

"The Mighty God"

"The Everlasting Father"

"Immanuel" which means God with us.

"YHWH"

"The Lord YHWH our Righteousness"

"Almighty God"

"Son of God"

Isaiah 9:6

6 For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

♣ Isaiah 7:14

14 Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and shall call His name Immanuel.

♣ Matthew 1:22-23

22 So all this was done that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the Lord through the prophet, saying:

23 "Behold, the virgin shall be with child, and

bear a Son, and they shall call His name Immanuel," which is translated, "God with us."

♣ Jeremiah 23:6

6 In His days Judah will be saved, and Israel will dwell safely; Now this is His name by which He will be called: THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS (YHWH Tsedekenu).

♣ Isaiah 40:3

3 The voice of one crying in the wilderness: "Prepare the way of the LORD YHWH; Make straight in the desert A highway for our God (Elohenu).

Hebrews 1:8

8 But to the Son He says: "Your throne, O God, is forever and ever; A scepter of righteousness is the scepter of Your Kingdom.

♣ 1 Timothy 3:16

16 And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God who was manifested in the flesh, Justified in the Spirit, Seen by angels, Preached among the Gentiles, Believed on in the world, Received

up in glory.

♣ John 10:36

36 do you say of Him whom the Father sanctified and sent into the world, 'You are blaspheming,' because I said, 'I am the Son of God'?

Jesus is immutable because He is God. The personal name of our God YHWH is the combination of two verbs :

YHYH (He is and He shall be) + HAWA (He was).

Hence, YHWH means the immutable ever present God. This is similar to the personal name I AM which is (AHYA ke AHYA). Jesus name is YHWH and I AM. Jesus is immutable.

- **#** Hebrews 1:10-12
- 10 And: "You, LORD, in the beginning laid the foundation of the earth, and the heavens are the work of Your hands.
- 11 They will perish, but You remain; And they will all grow old like a garment;
- 12 Like a cloak You will fold them up, and they will be changed. But You are the same, and Your years will not fail."
- # Hebrews 13:8
- 8 Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

Jesus upholds and sustains all creation because He is God. He is God who sustains the creation every second of its existence.

- **♣** Colossians 1:17
- 17 And He is before all things, and in Him all things consist.
- ♣ Hebrews 1:3
- 3 who being the brightness of His glory and the express image of His person, and upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins, sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high.
- # Luke 10:22
- 22 All things have been delivered to Me by My Father, and no one knows who the Son is except the Father, and who the Father is except the Son, and the one to whom the Son wills to reveal Him."
- **♣** John 3:35
- 35 The Father loves the Son, and has given all things into His hand.

♣ John 17:2

2 as You have given Him authority over all flesh, that He should give eternal life to as many as You have given Him.

⊕ Ephesians 1:22

22 And He put all things under His feet, and gave Him to be head over all things to the ekklyssia (the elect).

Jesus is God because He will raise the dead and execute judgment. Only God can do that.

♣ John 5:21

21 For as the Father raises the dead and gives life to them, even so the Son gives life to whom He will.

♣ John 11:25

25 Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live.

♣ John 6:39-40

39 This is the will of the Father who sent Me, that of all He has given Me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up at the last day. 40 And this is the will of Him who sent Me, that everyone who sees the Son and believes in Him may have everlasting life; and I will raise him up at the last day."

Jesus made it clear that everyone who know Him, knows God and shall see God. And, everyone who receive and believe in Jesus, receives and believes in God.

- **₽** John 14:1
- 1 "Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me.
- **♣** John 14:7-10
- 7 "If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also; and from now on you know Him and have seen Him."
- 8 Philip said to Him, "Lord, show us the Father, and it is sufficient for us."
- 9 Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; so how can you say, 'Show us the Father'? 10 Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? The words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own authority; but the Father who dwells in Me does the works.

♣ John 12:44-45

44 Then Jesus cried out and said, "He who believes in Me, believes not in Me but in Him who sent Me.

45 And he who sees Me sees Him who sent Me.

♣ Mark 9:37

37 "Whoever receives one of these little children in My name receives Me; and whoever receives Me, receives not Me but Him who sent Me."

♣ John 5:23

23 that all should honor the Son just as they honor the Father. He who does not honor the Son does not honor the Father who sent Him.

♣ John 15:23

23 He who hates Me hates My Father also.

Jesus declared that His work is the same exact work as Abba God. The Jews knew that God provides His loving care to all the creation seven days a week. Jesus does the same. Jesus did not break the Sabbath, but as He was equal with God, He provides His loving care and healing seven days a week.

♣ John 5:17-18

17 But Jesus answered them, "My Father has been working until now, and I have been working."

18 Therefore the Jews sought all the more to kill Him, because He not only broke the Sabbath, but also said that God was His Father, making Himself equal with God.

Jesus is the Lord of the Sabbath. Jesus gave the Ten Commandments to Moses. Jesus works on the Sabbath to heal and to keep the creation. God does not break the Sabbath, but rather He does not drop the creation to oblivion on the Sabbath.

Beginning in the fourth century AD the pagan Christian Church rejected the Sabbath and began to worship the Sun-god on Sunday until today, but they call the worship to Jesus on Sunday. The pagan Christian church descrated God's commandment.

Keeping the Sabbath does not mean to refuse to do works of mercy and of healing.

Jesus declared that He is God and the Lord of the Sabbath because He is the One who gave the Ten Commandments to Moses and to Adam and Abraham before him.

- **Matthew 12:3-8**
- 3 But He said to them, "Have you not read what David did when he was hungry, he and those who were with him:

- 4 how he entered the house of God and ate the showbread which was not lawful for him to eat, nor for those who were with him, but only for the priests?
- 5 Or have you not read in the law that on the Sabbath the priests in the temple profane the Sabbath, and are blameless?
- 6 Yet I say to you that in this place there is One greater than the temple.
- 7 But if you had known what this means, 'I desire mercy and not sacrifice,' you would not have condemned the guiltless.
- 8 For the Son of Man is Lord of the Sabbath."

Jesus declared that the Temple of Jerusalem is His own Temple. He is God and with zeal not anger He cleansed the Temple from the money changers, the thieves.

- ♣ Matthew 21:9-14
- 9 Then the multitudes who went before and those who followed cried out, saying: "Hosanna to the Son of David! 'Blessed is He who comes in the name of the LORD!' Hosanna in the highest!"
- 10 And when He had come into Jerusalem, all the city was moved, saying, "Who is this?"
- 11 So the multitudes said, "This is Jesus, the prophet from Nazareth of Galilee."
- 12 Then Jesus went into the temple of God and drove out all those who bought and sold in the temple, and overturned the tables of the money changers and the seats of those who sold doves.
- 13 And He said to them, "It is written, 'My house shall be called a house of prayer,' but you have made it a 'den of thieves.' "
- 14 Then the blind and the lame came to Him in the temple, and He healed them.

Jesus, the baby Yashua, was born from the righteous Miriam but He was not of her own ovi (eggs). Jesus came completely as God.

God did not conjugate something with Miriam's eggs and created Jesus. Jesus was not created and He had no DNA from Mary. But, being in the form of a human, a weak fetus, he needed the nurturing loving care of Miriam for nine months. (Counting from the sixth month, Elul, we calculate that Jesus was born the following year on the Day of Pentecost in May/June. Do the calculation yourself. There is a chart and a study on the date of the birth of Jesus on this site: 123BibleStudy.com).

Some pagan Christians claim that as Zeus impregnated a woman (Alcmene princess of Argos) and had a son Hercules, so Jesus is similar to Hercules, i.e. a super human. This is a high blasphemy. Jesus had nothing from the DNA of Mary. Jesus was not half human and half god.

Jesus descended in His own unique body.

Jesus was God, and also Son of Man.

Luke 1:26-35

- 26 Now in the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent by God to a city of Galilee named Nazareth,
- 27 to a virgin betrothed to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David. The virgin's name was Mary.
- 28 And having come in, the angel said to her, "Rejoice, highly favored one, the Lord is with you; blessed are you among women!"
- 29 But when she saw him, she was troubled at his saying, and considered what manner of greeting this was.
- 30 Then the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God.
- 31 And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bring forth a Son, and shall call His name JESUS.
- 32 He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Highest; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David.
- 33 And He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there will be no end."
- 34 Then Mary said to the angel, "How can

this be, since I do not know a man?"
35 And the angel answered and said to her,
"The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the
power of the Highest will overshadow you;
therefore, also, that Holy One who is to be
born will be called the Son of God.

♣ Romans 1:1-4

- 1 Paul, a bondservant of Jesus Christ, called to be an apostle, separated to the gospel of God
- 2 which He promised before through His prophets in the Holy Scriptures,
- 3 concerning His Son Jesus Christ our Lord, who was born of the seed of David according to the flesh,
- 4 and declared to be the Son of God with power according to the Spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead.

The resurrection of Jesus by His own power is a clear evidence that He is God. Jesus walked out of the grave by His own power. He showed that He is the God of the creation and death has nothing on Him.

♣ Romans 1:1-4

- 1 Paul, a bondservant of Jesus Christ, called to be an apostle, separated to the gospel of God
- 2 which He promised before through His prophets in the Holy Scriptures,
- 3 concerning His Son Jesus Christ our Lord, who was born of the seed of David according to the flesh,
- 4 and declared to be the Son of God with power according to the Spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead.

+ Acts 4:33

33 And with great power the apostles gave witness to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. And great grace was upon them all.

1 Corinthians 15:13

13 But if there is no resurrection of the dead,

then Christ is not risen.

- + 1 Corinthians 15:21
- 21 For since by man came death, by Man also came the resurrection of the dead.

Jesus declared that He is God, the One and only God.

He did not declare Himself to be a created god, or a lesser god, or a second god. God has no parts or levels or hierarchies within Himself. God is One. The Son of God, the Holy Spirit, and Abba Father God are One and the same although each has specific functions.

Jesus is the One God.

- **♣** Deuteronomy 6:4-9
- 4 "Hear, O Israel: YHWH the LORD our God, YHWH the LORD is one!
- 5 You shall love YHWH the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength.
- 6 "And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart.
- 7 You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up.
- 8 You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your

eyes.

9 You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.

The Trinity concept presented by the Church is not only confusing and tangential, but also it has its origins in the Greek philosophy and mythology and the Manichean philosophy cult of Augustine.

God is One Triune in nature. God is not three.

Jesus is YHWH. Hear ye Israel (the true believers), Jesus YHWH is One with Abba Father and with the Holy Spirit.

Anyone who hears the voice of Jesus shall be saved.

Hearing is not only by the ears, but also by the heart, the mind and the obedient life. Finally, what if someone still does not believe that Yeshua Jesus is the very person of God?

The answer is simple, if Jesus is not God, there can never be redemption (salvation).

God only can save us and no other.

Let us reject the false teachings of the churches and the pastors and the preachers who are leading us astray from the Bible.

Brothers and sisters who are professing Christ, do not be followers of men (your pastors and preachers). Be followers of Jesus through the Scriptures only.

It is true that 90% of all the pastors and all the Christians are false believers who compromised the Bible with many worldly and demonic teachings without knowing.

Study the Scripture by yourself. Show yourself approved before God.

If you are a pastor, stop taking God's money for yourself, it is a robbery. Stop making the church a business. Serve God freely without getting paid to show that you are a true and honest servant as did all the Apostles and the early disciples.

Remember, 90% of the pastors and 90% of the Christians are not truly born again.
Remember also that the Church is not the Ekklyssia. Jesus built the Ekklyssia, but people and emperor Constantine built the Church.

The Church is truly a "Socio-Pyramidal-Political-Religious-Business-Organization."

The Ekklyssia is not the Church. The Ekklyssia is the true congregation of the believers who are called out by Christ to be children of God.

Believe in Jesus, the Son of God and the Son of Man and you shall be saved.
