

Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation is a one-day training event that introduces parents and leaders to the skills needed to plan and conduct pack outdoor activities, particularly pack camping. The training includes: Planning, Equipment, Campfire Planning & Demonstration, Cub Scout Cooking & Food Preparation, Health & Safety, First Aid & Sanitation, Nature Hikes & Games. In order for a pack to go camping, at least one adult must be BALOO trained and must attend the camping overnight. Any adult who is involved with pack activities is encouraged to

participate. The more trained adults your unit has, the better your camp program will be.
