- 2. Applicant must have SOFA status as the dependent of an active duty, reserve, guard, retired, DoD civilian, or DoD contractor currently stationed on Okinawa. Both the active-duty member and the dependent child applying must be listed on orders/civilian LOA.

Important Information:

- 1.The Marine Thrift Shop will award 2 \$2,000 scholarships to two SOFA dependent (non-spouses). Scholarship will be paid directly to the institution attending and used for educational expenses. Should the recipient fail to attend a college or university during the 2023-24 academic year, the scholarship will be forfeited.
- 2. The scholarship will be awarded without the service member's rank and the applicant's and service member's age, race, gender, religion, sexual orientation, or ethnicity being considered.
- 3. Applications will be judged on: volunteer and community service history, work history, extracurriculars, honors and awards and essay content (to include content as well as spelling and grammar).
- 4. All the applicant's personally identifiable information will be unknown to the judges until after judging is complete.
- 5. Only complete applications turned in by the deadline will be considered.

- 1. All applications must be submitted no later than 11:59 PM on April 15, 2023.

In person applications must be received by a Manager; any application dropped off outside of operating hours will not be considered.
