1. Volunteer Parking-

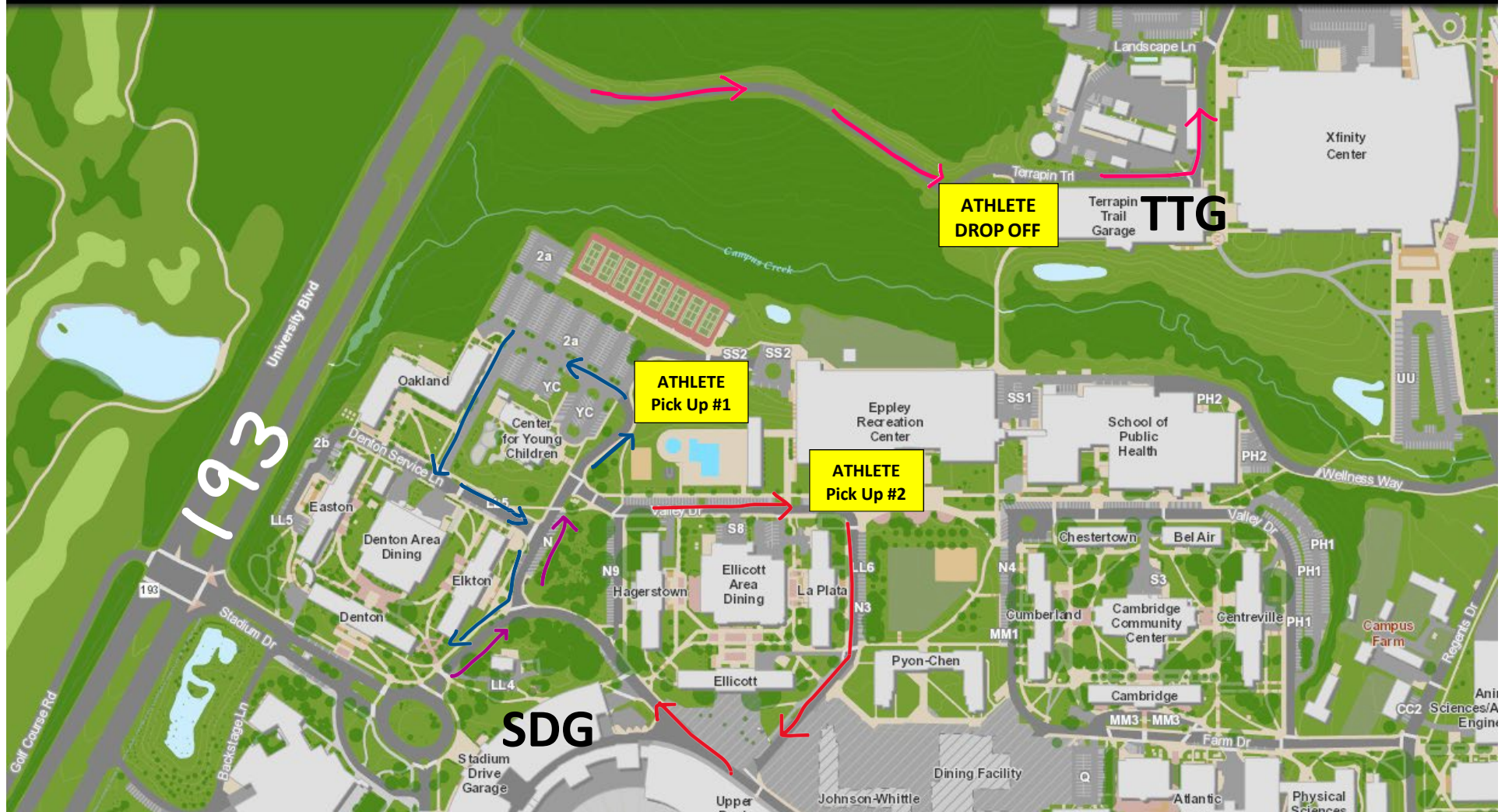

2. Athlete Parking and Drop off-

- Athletes who are old enough to drive themselves can use the same parking information above.
- For all other athletes:
 - o DROP OFF: Please see the attached map. Athlete drop off is at Terrapin Trail Garage (TTG) We will have volunteers available to group athletes together and guide them around the sidewalks to the athlete entrance. Please enter from Rt 193, drop off, drive PAST the Xfinity Center, and exit campus
 - o PICK UP: There are 2 pick up places:
 - Pick up #1 is near the Tennis Courts. This should be used by all teams EXCEPT NCAP and MACHINE. At no point will cars be allowed past the tennis courts into the traffic circle by the athlete entrance
 - Pick up #2 is at the top of the Stairs outside the facility. Athletes will walk up the stairs and meet their ride. NCAP athletes should arrange to meet in front of the main entrance. MACHINE athletes should arrange to meet to the right of the stairs, by the metered parking spaces.
 - PLEASE FOLLOW THE ONE WAY TRAFFIC PATTERNS NOTED ON THE INCLUDED MAPS

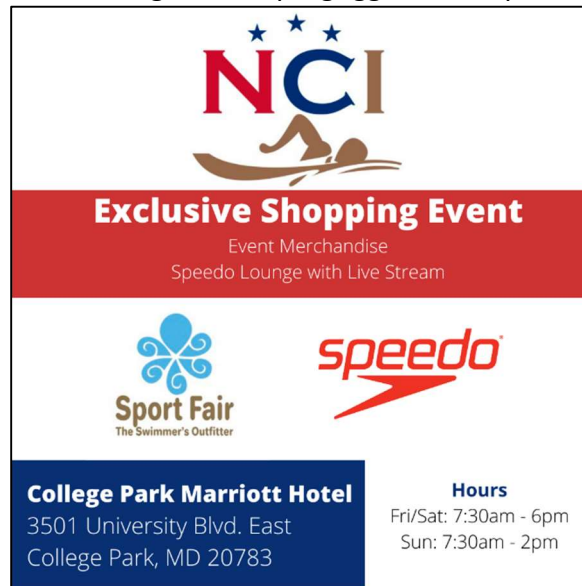


ALL ATHLETES ARE DROPPED OFF AT TERRAPIN TRAIL GARAGE
