

Folkestone and Hythe Birds

Tetrad Guide: TR23 I

(Folkestone Town and Sugarloaf Hill to Dover Hill)



Introduction

The northern part of Folkestone's outer harbour is found in the extreme south-east of the tetrad, and adjacent to this is a sandy beach (known as "Sunny Sands") and a small area of sea. Much of the tetrad is taken up by Folkestone town and comprises residential areas. The Pent Stream runs south-eastwards through the tetrad before discharging into the inner harbour (in TR13 H) but now only flows above ground when it passes through Radnor Park, where there are also two small lakes. Running along the northern boundary of the tetrad is part of the Folkestone to Etchinghill Escarpment SSSI from Sugarloaf Hill to Dover Hill.

Habitats and birds

Folkestone Harbour attracts a good number of the regular gull species and Glaucous, Iceland, Caspian and Yellow-legged have all been recorded on multiple occasions. Small numbers of Redshank and Turnstone overwinter here, with other waders such as Sanderling, Dunlin and Knot possible usually in colder weather, whilst Black Redstart and Rock Pipits are regular, often with Little Egret and Kingfisher in winter, and sometimes Shag. Oddities have included Mandarin Duck, Pochard, Long-tailed Duck, Leach's Petrel, Grey Phalarope, Little Auk and a presumed escaped Wood Duck. Much of the harbour is located within TR23 H and most older records and some recent ones have not been specific in relation to the tetrad so not all these species are included in the TR23 I bird list.

The sands to the east of the harbour also attract gulls and the occasional wader, including Bar-tailed Godwit and Common Sandpiper, when undisturbed and a range of commoner seabirds have been noted close inshore, as well as a Black-throated Diver in August 2014. At the eastern end of the sands a path leads up to Wear Bay Road, and there is a brick shelter here which provides a vantage point for seawatching. Most seabird records have been included in TR23 N as they passed at a distance from the shore and outside of the tetrad.

The town itself provides nesting sites for Common Swifts and for roof-nesting gulls, with up to 230 breeding pairs of Herring Gulls counted in a survey in 2019 (which constitutes over 40% of the 10km hectad total). Up to five pairs of Lesser Black-backed Gulls were also noted, whilst in 2022 a pair of Great Black-backed Gulls nested on a roof at the Park Farm industrial estate (the first occurrence locally).

Gardens within the town can attract migrants in season, with Firecrest, Spotted Flycatcher, Pied Flycatcher, Black Redstart, Redstart and even the first area (and third county) record of Dark-eyed Junco in a garden at Foreland Avenue in May 2010.

Flyover raptors have included a Black Kite (in April 2011), a Hen Harrier, and numerous Honey Buzzards, Red Kites, Marsh Harriers and Ospreys, whilst White Stork, Barnacle Goose, Spotted Redshank, Greenshank, Ring-necked Parakeet, Pallid Swift (two in November 1999) and Alpine Swift (in July 1996) have also been noted overhead.

Another Alpine Swift spending three days in the area between the 5th and 7th April 2010, roosting overnight under the eaves of the St. Andrew's Flats in The Durlocks, whilst Serins have flown over the seawatch shelter on several occasions. Waxwings have occurred in some years, with particularly large numbers on Park Farm Road in December 2010 when there was an exceptional peak of 500 on the 11th. There is a historical record of a Hoopoe at Radnor Park and the small lakes there have held nesting Coot on occasion, whilst a Jack Snipe was seen during cold weather in January 2021 and an Egyptian Goose in March 2021.

The escarpment in the north of the tetrad can be productive for migrants and has seen some good arrivals, including peak counts of 100+ Chiffchaffs in September 2013, 35 Ring Ouzels and 2,500 Redwings in October 2013, 130 Goldcrests and 240 Song Thrushes in October 2015 and 900 Fieldfares in October 2016. Scarcer sightings have included a Wryneck in September 2012 and a Yellow-browed Warbler in October 2013. There is a historical record too of Golden Oriole from Sugarloaf Hill.

Access and parking

The northern part of the harbour and the sands can be accessed by parking on Wear Bay Road (where there is free parking) and taking one of the paths to the south, or through TR23 H (as per the directions in that tetrad guide). The escarpment can be reached by parking in one of the lay-bys on Crete Road East and exploring to the south. Folkestone bus station and Folkestone central rail stations are both located within the tetrad which is well served by public transport.

Bird species diversity

An overall total of 150 species have been recorded within the tetrad, which ranks as the 12th richest in diversity amongst the 31 local tetrads as the table below demonstrates. The number of breeding and wintering species relate to those recorded in the 2007-2013 BTO/KOS atlas fieldwork.

Other Natural History

The tetrad has a rich history of moth records due to Arthur Macdonell Morley running a light trap here for over 40 years. A. M. Morley (as he is more usually referred to) was an eminent lepidopterist and president of the Folkestone Natural History Society (until ill health forced him to retire), and in 1931 he published “A List of the Butterflies and Moths (Macro-lepidoptera) occurring in the Neighbourhood of Folkestone”.

Morley was resident at 9 Radnor Park West from at least 1929 until his death in October 1972, aged 93. Of the many species that he added to the area list, 13 have not yet been recorded in any other tetrad: the Lappet, Oblique Carpet, Clouded Magpie and Scarce Dagger (in 1951), Feathered Ear and Double Dart (in 1952), Bordered Gothic (in 1953), Great Prominent (in 1954), Portland Moth (in 1955), Scarce Black Arches (in 1956), Bleached Pug (in 1957).

Amongst his other more noteworthy captures were Broom-tip, Common Fan-foot, Striped Hawk-moth, Oblique Striped, Sharp-angled Carpet, the Streak, Birch Mocha, Star-wort, Large Nutmeg, Clay Fan-foot, Three-humped Prominent, True Lover's Knot, Antler Moth, the Chevron, Small Marbled, Garden Dart and Juniper Carpet.

He noted several wanderers from Folkestone Downs/Warren, including Barred Tooth-striped, Sub-angled Wave, Lace Border, Chalk Carpet, Straw Belle, White Spot, Rest Harrow, the Annulet, Clouded Buff, *Moitrelia obductella* (Kent Knot-horn) and *Sitochroa palealis* (Sulphur Pearl). Regular migrants were also noted, including Hummingbird Hawk-moth, the Gem, Bordered Straw, Small Mottled Willow and the Delicate.

R. W. Fawthrop was operating a light trap on the opposite site of Radnor Park in the 1950s and his most significant capture was the only area record of Golden-rod Brindle on the 4th September 1954 (this was part of the first arrival of the Central European form *cinerascens* into Britain which involved 17 individuals, with only five singles having since been noted in the country). He also added Pale Eggar to the area list in 1955 (with Morley catching the only other, in 1957), whilst Crescent Striped, the Confused and White Colon have also not yet been recorded in any other tetrad.

More recently Paul Howe trapped Small Seraphim, Sussex Emerald and Dark Crimson Underwing in a garden in Stuart Road in 2008, an Oleander Hawk-moth was found alive inside a house next to Radnor Park in August 2018 and Cathy Hearsey has caught the first modern area record of Scarce Merveille du Jour in June 2021, a Crimson Speckled in October 2022 and several Golden Twin-spots in a garden in Dolphins Road.

The tetrad contains the easternmost part of the Folkestone Escarpment SSSI – an extensive area of chalk grassland and scrub located on the steep escarpment between Etchinghill and Capel-le-Ferne. This site is one of the largest remaining areas of unimproved chalk downland in Kent.

The escarpment holds a good selection of butterflies including Dingy Skipper, Wall, Green Hairstreak, Marbled White, Brown Argus, Adonis Blue, Small Blue and Chalk Hill Blue. Brimstones have been seen on occasion, as have the migrant species Clouded Yellow and Painted Lady. A White-letter Hairstreak was seen in Kingsnorth Gardens in the town in 2007.

A variety of moth species that are characteristic of downland are also found on the escarpment, including Straw Belle (particularly in the Sugarloaf Hill area), *Acompsia schmidtiellus* (Majorum Crest), *Ethmia terminella* (Five-spot Ermel), *Ethmia bipunctella* (Bordered Ermel), *Mompha miscella* (Brown Cosmet), *Agapeta zoegana* (Knapweed Conch), *Cochylimorpha alternana* (Kentish Conch), *Oncocera semirubella* (Rosy-striped Knot-horn), *Pyrausta nigrata* (Wavy-barred Sable), *Pyrausta purpuralis* (Common Purple & Gold), Mother Shipton, Clouded Buff, Small Purple-barred, Wood Carpet, Broken-barred Carpet and Sub-angled Wave.

Trapping at Smallpox Hill by Brian Harper and Ian Roberts in recent years has produced some particularly notable captures, including the first area (and ninth county) record of Cloaked Pug in June 2019, and the fourth area (and 18th national) record of Banded Pine Carpet and about the eighth area record of Silver Barred in June 2022.

The escarpment is home to the rare Late Spider Orchid and various other orchid species including Early Spider, Fragrant, Bee, Lizard and Man. The south-facing slopes are also perfect for Adders and other reptiles. The small area of coast adds significantly to the variety of species that have been recorded, in particular the crustaceans, molluscs and algae.

A list of all species recorded in the tetrad is provided below in Appendix 2.

General History

The tetrad contains Martello Tower number 2 of 74 which were built (and are numbered sequentially) along the coastline between Folkestone (1) and Seaford, Sussex (74). This tower, which was built in 1806 to meet the threat of invasion from Napoleonic France, is situated just inland from Wear Bay Road near St. Mary's School. The slightly tapering, circular tower is about 30 feet high with brick walls 5.5 feet to 6 feet thick that are covered with cement render. It was converted to residential accommodation in the later twentieth century and is now a grade II listed building.

One of the dominant features in the landscape is the 100-foot-tall viaduct that crosses Foord Road in the south of the tetrad. Constructed in less than six months, the viaduct which comprises nineteen arches was opened in 1843. As the highest arched brick viaduct in the world it was Grade II listed in 1975.


In 1855 St. Mary's National School was founded in Dover Road. Built on a deed of grant from Earl Radnor of Folkestone it comprised a series of neat Gothic buildings of Kentish ragstone, with Caen stone mouldings and dressings. The school moved to new premises in Warren Road in 1982. Part of the Dover Road site is now occupied by Dover Road Social Club and Folkestone Amateur Boxing Club, whilst the other part was demolished in 1994 and replaced by five town houses known as St Mary's Terrace. One of the Headmasters of the school was an important figure in the local historical context: Henry Ulliyett.

Henry Ulliyett (1838 – 1898) was the Founder Secretary of Folkestone's Natural History Society (F.N.H.S) in April 1868. Henry was also a Fellow of the Royal Geographic Society, the originator of Art and Science classes in Folkestone, a well-known science lecturer and held a Bachelor of Science degree.


The F.N.H.S. wrote to the Mayor of Folkestone in 1868 to ask for the museum at Sessions Hall, beside the Bayle Steps in the High Street, to be placed under its charge. It explained that one of its objectives was "to collect specimens connected with natural history, with which the neighbourhood of Folkestone so richly abounds" ... and that it was "very anxious to secure some place where the specimens may be exhibited". After a short delay, the care of the museum was taken in hand by the society in 1870, and it was formally re-opened on the 4th October of that year by the Mayor, with Henry Ulliyett as its President. In 1888 it transferred to a purpose-built museum and library building, which is its current location on Grace Hill, where it occupies the first floor and a memorial plaque dedicated to Henry Ulliyett is currently displayed.

The museum housed a collection of bird's eggs and skins but these were not as remarkable as E. C. Joy's British Butterflies (two twenty-draw cabinets regarded as one of the best one-man collections in the country) or A. E. Eastes' extensive herbarium of dried flower specimens dating back to the early nineteenth century.

The F.N.H.S. was responsible for some landmark publications. In 1870 it published a “list of macro-lepidoptera occurring in the neighbourhood of Folkestone” (written by Dr. Henry Guard Knaggs) and in 1871 a “list of birds observed in Folkestone and its immediate neighbourhood” (complied by Valentine Knight and Frederick Tolputt) followed. Both of these lists are available on the website: www.folkestonebirds.com/lists and were included with a small volume entitled *“Rambles of a Naturalist round Folkestone”* which Henry Ullgett published in 1880. This publication also included details of the “only spot in the neighbourhood where the Sand Martins used to build”, which was in this tetrad, “near the old Pavilion Gardens” (between Foord and Park Farm).

The building known as St Andrew's Flats, on the Durlocks, was originally St Andrew's Convalescent Home, run by an order of Anglican nuns known as the Sisterhood of St John Baptist, Clewer. In 1864, a small group of the Clewer Sisters came to live in Folkestone, where they helped to establish St Peter's and St Saviour's Churches, built their own mission chapel, and worked amongst the poorest in the east part of Folkestone.

St Andrews was designed by the British architect Ewan Christian. St Peter's Church was built in 1862 as a chapel-of-ease for the Parish church and in 1868 it was consecrated and became an independent Parish Church. St Saviour's Church was consecrated in 1900 and is Grade II listed as a large, late Victorian Gothic Revival church in the Perpendicular style and presenting a vibrant polychrome exterior of ragstone and red brick and terracotta.

Smallpox Hill is named after a former Smallpox hospital that was opened in 1877 and was situated just to the west of the bottom of the hill. Traces of it can still be found today. Just a couple of hundred metres away a Saxon burial ground was discovered on Dover Hill during road widening works in 1907. A complete Saxon skeleton from this site is now housed in Folkestone History Resource Centre in Folkestone Library (in the south of the tetrad). An old lime kiln is situated opposite the burial ground.

Kingsnorth Gardens is so named due to John Kingsnorth, once a tenant farmer at Ingles Farm. He excavated the former position of the gardens for brick earth. Following this the site was turned over to allotments and then became an area for dumping refuse. Following complaints the Town Council developed it as an ornamental garden, including terracing and ponds. It opened in June 1928.


