It's not All About Me

And it's not all about you. But it's about us, and the times we're in.

I came across this item from the Catholic News Agency, and it's a reminder to each of us to look after ourselves and each other.

In the week before 15 January, nine Catholic bishops died worldwide after testing positive for COVID-19. They ranged in age from 53 years old to 91. Five of the bishops died in Europe.

Four bishops died 13 January: <u>Archbishop Philip Tartaglia</u> of Glasgow (aged 70); <u>Bishop Moses Hamungole</u> of Monze, Zambia (aged 53); 87-year-old Bishop Mario Cecchini of Fano, Italy; and <u>Cardinal Eusébio</u> Oscar Scheid, the 88-year-old retired archbishop of Rio de Janeiro, Brazil.

Bells tolled across the Colombian diocese of Santa Marta on Jan. 12 to honour <u>Bishop Luis Adriano Piedrahita Sandoval</u>, 74, who died on 11 January of complications from COVID-19. <u>Bishop Cástor Oswaldo Azuaje</u> of Trujillo, 69, became the first bishop from Venezuela to die after contracting the virus on 8 January.

Bishop Florentin Crihalmeanu, the 61-year-old bishop of the Greek-Catholic Eparchy of Cluj-Gherla in Romania, died on 12 January. Two of the bishops were retired: Polish Bishop Adam Dyczkowski, died on 10 January (aged 88) and Italian Archbishop Oscar Rizzato (aged 91) died on 11 January.
