RECLAIMING HER VOICE ...TO END DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

Facts

One in every 4 women will experience domestic violence in her lifetime.* One in 5 will have her first experience of this violence between the ages of 11-17.* **Houston, we have a problem.** Her Voice was founded in response to this ever growing issue in our community. No longer can we pretend it isn't happening because it is. Now it's time to do something about it.

Purpose

Her VOICE is a non-profit organization founded in 2014. This organization is dedicated to empowering survivors of Intimate Partner Violence (IPV) or Domestic Violence (DV) through mentorship and education.

Program

This program is a three level mentorship program. Women who have been survivors of abuse and apart from their abusive relationship for a minimum of 2 years will mentor other survivors who have gone through a treatment program or DV shelter program in the last year. These women will be matched for 1 year and engage in both organized and community based programming and events. Teen girls will also be mentored as part of this program to encourage prevention of dating violence. This program is FREE and both mentor and mentee will receive training and support.
