God's People Confess Their Faith Westminster Larger Catechism No.45

Christ executes the office of a king, in calling out of the world a people to Himself, and giving them officers, laws, and censures, by which He visibly governs them; in bestowing saving grace upon His elect, rewarding their obedience, and correcting them for their sins, preserving and supporting them under all their temptations and sufferings, restraining and overcoming all their enemies, and powerfully ordering all things for His own glory, and their good; and also in taking vengeance on the rest, who know not God, and obey not the gospel.

God Calls His People to Repentance

For I know that nothing good dwells in me, that is, in my flesh. For I have the desire to do what is right, but not the ability to carry it out. For I do not do the good I want, but the evil I do not want is what I keep on doing...Wretched man that I am! Who will deliver me from this body of death? (Romans 7:18–19, 24)

God's People Confess Their Sin

O most merciful eternal God our Father, we confess the majesty of Your holiness and righteousness and that we are miserable sinners. We were conceived in sin, born in sin, and powerless to escape bondage to sin. You have freed us from the power and penalty of sin through the death of Your Son in our place, and yet we have not

loved You as we ought, we have not responded with perfect obedience and faith, and so we come begging You to forgive us all our sins, and restore the light of Your face upon us, because of Christ our King.


