Being in receipt of the required documentation and by virtue of this letter, *"Queen of the Holy Rosary Shrine"* is recognized as a lay association of the Lay Faithful in the Archdiocese of Toronto.

This recognition is effective immediately and is valid until it is revoked.

This recognition accorded to the associations within the archdiocesan territory is a pastoral recognition that does not convoke a new canonical status.

What the archdiocesan recognition is meant to provide is support and pastoral vigilance in ensuring that an association's purpose is conducted in accord with the Church's teachings on faith and morals, and that its actions are shepherded according to ecclesiastical discipline [CIC c. 305].
