Thank you for your interest in the 2016 Lick Skillet Quilt Show. Entries will be evaluated by a nationally recognized judge, and ribbon awards will be given at the discretion of the judges. # **Entry Submission**

Individual entries will not be accepted until ALL required items are received and the entry form is COMPLETELY and accurately filled out.

#### Each entry shall consist of:

- · Completed Entry Form-with signature & contact info
- Entry Fee
  - One CLEAR color photo of the entry (can be printed on any White paper up to letter size),
    labeled with the entrant's name, quilt title and size dimensions of entry indicated (width x
    length). Photos will not be returned

#### **Entry Deadline:**

#### Postmarked by Monday, August 15, 2016

## **Entry Limits:**

- Each entrant may submit a maximum of five (5) entries.
  - No more than 2 quilts may be entered in a category.
- Only the first 200 entries will be accepted.

#### **Entry Fees:**

- Guild members in good standing (dues paid) are exempt from entry fees.
- Non-Members of the Guild are required to pay a non-refundable entry fee of \$15 per entry.

### **Entry Form**

- A category must be selected on each entry form.
- The "one person" category means that one person did all the work piecing, applique, quilting, binding, etc. A quilt professionally quilted by someone else must be entered in the "two person" categories.
- No substitution of the original entry will be allowed.
- Entry may NOT have been entered in previous LSQG show.
- The Entries Committee reserves the right to determine the final placement of quilts in categories, and to combine or divide categories in order to facilitate judging.
- All quilts entered must have the quilt top completed at the time of entry submission. The required photo needs to clearly SHOW THE QUILT.
- Entries must have been completed after January 1, 2011 (within the past 5 years), be clean and in good condition.
- The Quilters Guild reserves the right to refuse any entry which fails to meet entry and/or delivery requirements.

#### **Categories Accepted (see detailed description)**

- Wall Quilt -- less than 240 inches perimeter—1 or 2 person
- Bed Quilt greater than 240 inches perimeter 1 or 2 person
- Miniature Quilt less than 96 inches perimeter 1 or 2 person
- Art Quilt any size, an original work
- Modern --- no size restrictions 1 or 2 person
- LSQG Member challenge
- Youth Quilters 16 and under any size
- Display only any size—space permitting

#### **Quilting/Construction Requirements**

- All entries entered in quilt categories must be quilted with the exception of cathedral window quilts, yo-yo quilts or crazy guilts. No tied guilts will be allowed.
- All entries MUST remain on display for the duration of the show.
- A four-inch sleeve must be sewn to the top back of all quilts, unless it is a miniature quilt, then the sleeve may be appropriately sized. Quilts received without a sleeve will not be judged or displayed. If your quilt is longer than 96", the sleeve needs to be placed 12" from the top.
- Each quilt must be in a cloth bag or pillowcase that has your name and phone number clearly written on it.

#### **Entries May Not:**

- Be framed and/or under glass.
- Include embellishments with sharp edges that could be hazardous to volunteers or visitors.

# **Entry Withdrawals**

We strongly discourage the withdrawal of entries from the show. If you find that you must withdraw an entry, the Entries Chairman must be notified via email or phone no later than 4:30 PM on **Wednesday, August 31**, **2016** – two weeks prior to the delivery date (9-17-2016).

#### **Shipping & Delivery Instructions**

- Shipped quilts must be mailed to arrive between September 9<sup>th</sup> and the 14th. Please send to Carolyn Davis, 3030 Airport Rd. Oxford, AL. 36203. Remember to include return instructions if you will NOT be picking up your quilt in person at the end of the show. Shipped entries will be returned the week after the show. Your entry must include a prepaid return shipping label.
- Hand delivered quilts should be presented to the receiving committee Saturday, September 17, 2016 at
   Alabama Power Company auditorium, 925 Quintard Avenue, Anniston, AL between the hours of 9am and 4pm.
