Dear Parents/Guardians,

We also encourage you and your child to explore available resources at your local library to help facilitate your summer reading journey. We recommend you use any of the following reading strategies to spark your child's interest in reading and to help him/her engage in the text:

- engage in ongoing discussions about your child's book during family time, or leisure activities
- read to each other and talk about books in general
- ask your child questions and make a connection between events in the book to his/her life
- maintain a reading journal, or sticky notes, to comment, summarize, and even illustrate key events
- help your child make inferences and understand main ideas by "reading between the lines"
