Important Notice:

Taylor Dunn, UMBC graduate & Co-Founder of The Rose Foundation, received “*NBC News 40 and under Community Award*” for providing free prom dresses and make-overs for hundreds of high school girls living in underserved communities. **The Taylor Dunn Scholarship** is for students who want to pursue a career in the field of Social Work.

Please make sure that you meet the eligibility requirements below before you complete and submit your application. You must be a resident of Maryland. You **must be a high school senior** accepted as a **full-time student at the University of Maryland of Baltimore County (UMBC) seeking a Social Work degree** as an undergraduate student. You must identify as African-American, Black, and/or Hispanic race. You must have a minimal GPA above a 2.3 cumulative average. You must attach a copy of your high school transcript, (unofficial or official), (2) letters of recommendation and proof residency.

Applicants must submit a one-page, typed, double-spaced essay on “**How You Will Use Your Degree to Help Bring Change to Your Community.**” Essay must be typed with minimal errors. Completed application packets will include: **signed application, essay, (2) letters of recommendation, transcript and proof of residency.**

Award amounts are between \$500-\$1000 per academic school year. All awards will be based on eligibility requirements met and funds available.
