Primary Class

We are excited for fall and a month filled with fun learning activities! The children will love some of the special Halloween themed work they will begin to find on the shelves.

This month in Science we will begin our lessons in Botany and Zoology. In Botany, we will start with an overview of all the parts of the plant, then begin focusing specifically on leaves and how they help the plant. We will also learn about and explore the changing color of the leaves that we see.
