The design for this card is taken from an 1889 pattern that was most probably a supplement to a French lady's magazine. (Conseiller des dames et des demoiselles – 1st January 1889)

The little rhyme is taken from the Hill's Manual, also from 1889

The card is stitched in silk threads, on perforated paper, the conversion to DMC is from the chart available on the hand dyed fibers side.
