Dear brothers and sisters,

Summer is almost at the end, and we are starting to look into going back to a more “normal routine”. 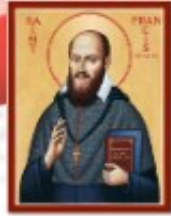
