Our dear friend David Joel Pichler died unexpectedly at the young age of 34 in February 2011. In an effort to honor his memory in a way consistent with his life experiences and values, a group of his family and friends have created the *David J. Pichler Memorial Scholarship Award* at Stuyvesant High School. The scholarship is awarded annually to a graduating senior at Stuyvesant High School who has excelled in mathematics and plans to attend Dartmouth College the following fall.

The scholarship highlights many aspects of David's life. Both David and his sister Judy graduated from Stuyvesant, and their mother Natalie is a retired teacher from the New York City Public School system. David graduated from Dartmouth with a degree in Mathematics and from The Wharton School with an MBA, both of which served as a foundation for a successful career in finance. David's father Hermann, who tragically passed away in 2016, had said how proud he was that David attended both schools, and how grateful he was that it was made possible. We hope to lighten the financial burden of many future students and help them realize their educational dreams.

This year, we are honored to present the eleventh annual *David J. Pichler Memorial Scholarship Award* of \$7,000 to graduating senior **Carter Ley**, who will be matriculating at Dartmouth in the fall.
