## Tetrad Guide: TR13 N


### (Sandling, Postling Wents and surrounding areas)



#### Introduction

The tetrad TR13 N is comprised by a significant proportion of woodland, as it contains Bartholomew's Wood, Thorn Wood, Cowtye Wood, Bluehouse Wood, House Wood, Chesterfield Wood, Heane Wood, Willow Wood and the American Garden. To the north of the M20, which bisects the tetrad, the land is mostly level and is largely used for arable farming, whilst to the south it is more undulating and primarily pastoral. The Brockhill Stream runs across the south-eastern monad, forming Sandling Park Lake, whilst the smaller Slay Brook arises within the tetrad. In the south-western corner of the tetrad the Garden House orchards may be found.

## Habitats and birds

The complex of woods provides much of the interest in TR13 N, including some important breeding species in the local context. The only confirmed breeding records in the breeding atlas of Firecrest (at House Wood) and Willow Warbler (at Bluehouse Wood) were in this tetrad, as well as the only probable breeding records of Garden Warbler (at Bluehouse Wood, Cowtye Wood and Heane Wood).

Confirmed breeding of Mandarin, probable Tufted Duck, Buzzard, Stock Dove and Nuthatch, and possible Little Grebe, Hobby, Cuckoo and Marsh Tit were other highlights from the wooded areas, whilst a pair of Spotted Flycatchers nested at Bartholomew's Wood in 2022. The surrounding open country holds breeding Red-legged Partridge, Skylark, Meadow Pipit, Linnet, Yellowhammer and Reed Bunting. In winter Woodcock frequent the woods, with small numbers of Siskin and Redpoll, and occasionally Brambling or Crossbill.

The arable farmland areas attract Lapwings, sometimes joined by a few Golden Plovers, and winter thrushes, whilst seasonally flooded areas can hold Green Sandpiper (particularly the field opposite the bridleway to Bluehouse).

Sandling Park Lake can hold good numbers of wintering wildfowl, with peak counts of 23 Mandarin, 32 Gadwall, 40 Pintail and 180 Teal, and occasionally attracts Wigeon, Shoveler and Pochard, with single records of Garganey and Goldeneye.

Redstart has occurred on passage, whilst flyover raptors in recent years have involved Red Kite, Marsh Harrier, Hen Harrier, Goshawk and Rough-legged Buzzard, and in autumn 2008 a satellite-tracked Osprey from Loch Garten spent two weeks in the area. Notable oddities have included Hooded Crow, Waxwing and Black-bellied Dipper.

Prior to their population declines, the tetrad formerly held breeding Turtle Dove, Lesser Spotted Woodpecker and Willow Tit, and probably Nightingale and Wood Warbler, and there have been a number of other interesting historical sightings in the tetrad. The first county record of Red-footed Falcon occurred in Sandling Park in the early part of the summer of 1862 and formed part of the collection of Mayor William Deedes of Saltwood Castle, having been shot by his gamekeeper, a Mr. B. Turner (Ticehurst 1909).

In the 1950s H. Schreiber was generating records from the Sandling Park area. Little is known of the observer but he was evidently also a bird ringer, and his captures included four dark-breasted Barn Owls during very hard weather in January 1960.

Perhaps the most significant observation he made was of Golden Orioles seen or heard near Sandling Station in the breeding season for four successive years from 1954. Also of note were regular records of Crossbills at Sandling Park, and singles there of Rough-legged Buzzard, Corncrake, Quail and Hoopoe, with some very notable counts of Mallard, Sparrowhawk, Grey Partridge, Water Rail, Woodcock and Jay, some of which are still record totals to date.

### Access and parking

There are several lay-bys on the A20 where it is possible to park for free or there are pay and display car parks at Sandling Station (see [www.apcoa.co.uk/parking-in/hythe/sandling-station](http://www.apcoa.co.uk/parking-in/hythe/sandling-station) for the latest prices) or just to the south of the tetrad at Brockhill Country Park (see TR13 M for details). Sandling Station is on the main Folkestone to Ashford train line and is also served by Stagecoach buses (refer to [www.stagecoachbus.com/timetables](http://www.stagecoachbus.com/timetables) for details).

A network of footpaths and bridleways run through or adjacent to most of the main wooded areas. Sandling Park is usually open to the public on just one day each year, in May (look out for details on the [www.pilgrimshospices.org](http://www.pilgrimshospices.org) website).

### Bird species diversity

The good mix of habitats that includes a significant proportion of woodland resulting in a total of 59 breeding species being recorded in the 2007-2013 BTO/KOS atlas fieldwork, which ranks as the sixth richest in diversity amongst the 31 local tetrads. The range of wintering species and the overall total of 122 species within the tetrad were more average, as the table below demonstrates.

### Other Natural History

A number of taxa have received very little attention here and there is clear potential to extend several of the lists that are given at the end, particularly as there is some good woodland habitat within the tetrad. Moth trapping since 2016 has greatly enlarged the lepidoptera list and revealed a number of very notable residents, including the Mocha, White-banded Carpet, Olive Crescent and the recent colonists *Catoptria verellus* (Marbled Grass-veen) and Dusky Hook-tip (which was discovered breeding in Britain for the first time in TR13 N). Other notable macro moths have included Gold Swift, Red-necked Footman, Barred Hook-tip, Clifden Nonpareil, the Suspected and Scarce Silver-lines.

This recent coverage has revealed a rich diversity of micro moths including some particularly noteworthy species in *Bisigna procerella* (Kent Tubic), *Teleiodes luculella* (Crescent Groundling), *Spatialistis bifasciana* (Small Purple Button), *Eulia ministrana* (Brassy Tortrix), *Hysterophora maculosana* (Bluebell Conch), *Assara terebrella* (Dark Spruce Knot-horn), *Rhodophaea formosa* (Beautiful Knot-horn), *Cryptoblabes bistriga* (Double-striped Knot-horn) and *Agrotera nemoralis* (Beautiful Pearl).

Several other micro moths have not been recorded in any other local tetrads to date: *Triaxomera fulvimitrella* (Four-spotted Clothes Moth), *Argyresthia glabratella* (Spruce Argent), *Crassa tinctella* (Tinted Tubic), *Monochroa tenebrella* (Common Plain Neb), *Batrachedra pinicolella* (Pine Cosmet) and *Pammene ochsenheimeriana* (Black-patch Piercer).

Rare migrants that have been recorded are the only area record of Beautiful Snout at Heane Wood in July 2017, the second area (and c.12<sup>th</sup> British) record of Banded Pine Carpet at Heane Wood in May 2020, the fourth area record of *Loxostege sticticalis* (Diamond-spot Pearl) at Heane Wood in July 2019 and the fourth area record of Blair's Mocha at Chesterfield Wood in June 2017.

Historical records include the only documented local sightings of Broad-bordered Bee Hawk-moth and Narrow-bordered Bee Hawk-moth, with both taken at Rhododendron in Sandling Park in 1947, whilst both Dark Crimson Underwing and Light Crimson Underwing were obtained there in around 1905.

Red-belted Clearwing and Purple Hairstreak have been found by day at Garden House orchards. Amongst the other taxa two species that have only recently become established in Britain are noteworthy: the longhorn beetle *Agapanthia cardui* (first found in Britain near the Channel Tunnel terminal in 2017) and Rambur's Pied Shieldbug (first found in Britain in Kent 2011). A list of all species recorded in the tetrad is provided below in Appendix 2.





## General History

The oldest feature of note within the tetrad is the Willow Wood Barrow, a Neolithic burial mound situated between Willow Wood and the Sandling Road, which is around 18.0m in diameter and 1.8m in height.

Saltwood is recorded under the name ‘Salteode’ in the Domesday Book of 1086. This is said to be derived from the earlier Old English form ‘Saltwuda’, meaning a wood where salt is made or stored. There are still extensively wooded areas within the parish, particularly in TR13 N. Situated in the extreme south-east of the tetrad is the Church of St. Peter and St. Paul, the earliest part of which dates from the twelfth century. The tower, added around 1200 A.D., originally had a gabled top (which is rather uncommon in England) but this was modified during the nineteenth century.

Close to where the footpath crosses Sandling Road sits Slaybrook House, a fifteenth century construction which was originally a farmhouse and is now a private residence. To the north-west lies Sandling Park. The original manor house here was built by the Italian architect Bonomi for the Deedes family in 1796 but much of the site was destroyed by enemy action in 1942. A modern replacement was built after the war and then the current house, designed by renowned British architect Quinlan Terry, was commissioned by Alan Hardy in 1999.

When Laurence Hardy purchased the property at Sandling Park in 1897 he employed Henry Milner to plan and plant the spectacular 25-acre Grade II Heritage Gardens. Some of the trees and early hybrid rhododendron and azaleas still exist and were added to over the next century by the Hardy family. The garden now includes 20 national champion trees (the best examples in the country), more than 200 wild-sourced trees which still retain their collector’s numbers, one of the finest azalea collections in the country and a specialist rhododendron collection.

The tetrad also boasts the American Garden, created by Archdeacon Croft (who was the rector of Saltwood) in 1820, which has another impressive array of azaleas, rhododendrons and other plants, including the Giant Redwoods from California that are thought to have given the garden its name.

Sandling Station was once a junction for a branch line that ran the three miles through Hythe to the old Sandgate Station and the dismantled track can be traced south-eastwards through the tetrad. Almost the entire route remains intact including cuttings and embankments, and an 85-metre tunnel situated just south of Heane Wood. It opened in 1874 and closed in 1951.
