A total entry of 5964 sheep through the ring on Monday.

Monday had multiple highlights but the main events including the Special Show & Sale of the Devon Closewool Society and the Exmoor Mule Ewe Lamb Show & Sale were the stars of the show.

**Exmoor Mule Ewe Lambs,** 1029 forward for sale met with an absolutely flying trade with ewe lambs exceeding expectations and selling to an average of £132.00 across the board with a 100% clearance.
