### NOTES FROM FR. VANDEWALLE

Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving - During Lent the Church asks us to increase these three. Here's some ideas that I borrowed from Bishop Barron. Of course you can't do all, but perhaps one, or one from each category, or of course creatively make your own: Prayer - "What the best way to improve my life of prayer? Take the time," says Thomas Merton. As with any friendship, it includes time spent with the other. There a thousand ways to pray. Here are some. (1) The daily rosary will change your life suggests Bishop Barron. (2) The "Jesus" prayer recited a number of times consecutively is another: "Lord Jesus Christ, Son of God, have mercy on me a sinner." (3) Meditation – A few minutes each day reflection on the gospel. Or simply sitting in the presence of the Lord: "here I am Lord, listening." Thomas Merton recommended "a half hour each day, unless you are busy, then an hour!" But any extra minutes are great! (4) Attend Daily Mass. Fast – The material good of the body are good, but lessening them can allow the spiritual desires to emerge. It helps order all the other things to God. Of course after the church days of fast or abstinence, Bishop Barron's ideas include some (1) food or (2) drink, (3) perhaps alcohol. (4) Some sin that you have been struggling with. To give it up for life, you might start with lent. The inventors of (5) social media meant for it to be addictive. Many choose to lessen their social media during lent. Give Alms – Alms express love in action, choosing the good for another. Those in need aren't just the poor. (1) Any service to someone in need is good. (2) Give 10% of your income during Lent to the poor. (3) Increase your normal tip by 5%. (4) Give to the charities that come in the mail for Lent. (5) Have loose money with you to give to those in need (6) Have a poor box at your door to drop money in whenever you leave the house, whether a dime or a dollar. It is a reminder to give to those in need. (7) Or choose one of the corporal or spiritual works of mercy to do more intensely for Lent.

A few changes for the Green Category - On January 30<sup>th</sup>, Governor Rickett's placed Nebraska in the "green category" opening up the state more. As a result, the Diocese changed some of its policies, leaving them up to the discretion of each pastor and recommending they consult with their parish council. Some things remain the same. The use of face masks when unable to maintain six feet of social distancing is still encouraged. Hand sanitizer is available at entrances. Priests and Acolytes will still use face masks when distributing Holy Communion. No shaking hands at the sign of peace. And Guidelines for school masses are still in place. After communicating with a number of parish council members about those things that were discretionary, here are some of the things we are implementing. Holy Water will be available in fonts. Of course these are optional for people to use or not. Missalettes will be available in the pews or in back of church. We have enough missalettes that those who are still concerned about Covid-19 to have the social distancing space they may wish to have. We will monitor the need to remove more ropes depending on attendance. We'll use the confessional again, unless you call for an appointment. We won't pass collection baskets yet. We will continue to have the choirs sing. Please be respectful of those who may still have concerns.
