What THINK ye of Jesus Christ? Whose SON is he?

In the Beginning was the WORD!

Every person that has ever been born WILL one day answer the question above: either in this life, or at the judgment.

Why? Because unlike some ministers and preachers, Jesus "...made himself OF NO REPUTATION, and took upon him the form of a SERVANT...wherefore God also hath highly exalted him...that at the name of Jesus EVERY knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; and that EVERY tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father" (PHILIP. 2:7-11).

Jesus declared, "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son" (JOHN 3:16). God Him-

self declared with "... a voice from heaven, saying, This is my beloved Son" (MATTHEW 3:17 & 17:5), but the world will not believe God.

Those of us that trust in God KNOW by faith that "...God was IN Christ, reconciling the world unto himself" (2 COR. 5:19), that is, reestablishing a close relationship.

Yet, when Jesus opened the eyes of the man born blind, the religious leaders said, "...This man is not of God" while others said, "How can a man that is a sinner do such miracles" (JOHN 9:16)?

WORDS TO REMEMBER...

- ◆ **John 3:18:** "He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God."
- ◆ **John 20:30-31:** "And many other signs truly did Jesus in the presence of his disciples, which are not written in this book: But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name."
