Tahj started the "Warming Hearts for the Homeless Initiative" which has provided hundreds of homeless families and individuals with warming items to assist them while living on the streets. **The Tahj Dunn Scholarship** was created for students who want to pursue a career field that helps improve the lives of others.

Please make sure that you meet the eligibility requirements below before you complete and submit your application. You must be a resident of Maryland. You must be a high school senior who will be attending **Bowie State University seeking a Behavior Science or Human Services degree** as an undergraduate student. You must identify as African-American, Black, and/or Hispanic race. You must have a minimal GPA above a 2.3 cumulative average. You must attach a copy of your **high official transcript**. You must submit (2) **letters of recommendation**. You must submit **proof of enrollment**.

Applicants must submit a one-page, typed, double-spaced essay on "**How You Will Use Your Degree to Help Bring Change to Your Community.**" Essay must be typed with minimal errors. Completed application packets will include: **signed application, essay, high school transcript, acceptance letter, letters of recommendation and proof of residency.**

Award amounts are between \$500-\$1000 per academic school year. Awardees will receive a letter of acceptance by May 30. Award amounts will be sent directly to university. All awards will be based on eligibility requirements met and funds available.
