

For your Studiobook Planning pages, you must include the following. Write the questions, answer in complete sentences with legible writing about the work. 4-5 sentences each minimum.

1. What is the main visual idea/question you are working with?
2. Summarize the process. What are the materials? What are the steps in your process? How is the material you used appropriate for both the idea and the process? What risks can you take with either process or materials?
3. Describe the discoveries you made during your planning/thinking.
4. Is there any artistic risk involved? What will you do to improve or refine the work?

Don't forget to include a thumbnail (4" x 6" or larger) of the actual work with accurate colors (if any). Show alternatives to the work, present a clear idea of what the piece will look like and why. Show possible changes or options the work could take. Show high quality linework, elements of art/principles of design and effort. Do not paste any images from the internet. Pages need to be numbered.
