- Item 1 A discussion on the syllabus and the possible addition of new techniques etc,

- Item 3 Discussion regarding a national kyu grade assessment system. This would include formalising who within the organisation is accredited to award grades at to what level. In Summary, the Camp was held on 7th & 8th September at Mount Avoca Winery. 7 athletes from the Mt Gambier and Ballarat dojo participated. 10 sessions were conducted by Shihan Alba and myself covering areas such as foot work, defensive and offensive techniques, Kata, sweeping and take down techniques.
