REFLECTIONS

Happy March to you all!

At this time of year, I struggle with the length of our winters and know others struggle, as well. All my life, I have never minded winter. I still enjoy it, but there is something about the end of February to the end of March that just gets to me. It is hard to put into words, but it is just a bummer or a drag to deal with the darkness, snow, and cold for this long. Do some of you feel my pain? Do we feel the disappointment when the weatherman tells us for the next couple of days it will be cold and when it does warm a bit, we will see snow? Yep. #### General Conference Postponed to 2022

Meeting on February 20, the Commission on the General Conference made a decision to further postpone the 2020 General Conference until August 29 – September 6, 2022 in Minneapolis, Minn. as the COVID-19 pandemic continues to affect the safety of mass gatherings and travel. A link to the full announcement is included below.

#### Bishops call Special Session of General Conference, create timeline for moving forward

WASHINGTON, D.C. – In response to the further postponement of the 2020 General Conference, the Council of Bishops (COB) is calling a Special Session of the General Conference of The United Methodist Church (UMC) to be convened online on May 8, 2021.

<u>According to the call letter signed</u> by COB President Bishop Cynthia Fierro Harvey, the Special Session will be held in accordance with Division Two - Section II - Article II of The Constitution of The United Methodist Church as recorded in Paragraph ¶14 of *The Book of Discipline* (2016).

The purpose of the 2021 Special Session of the General Conference will be limited to gaining a quorum in order to suspend the rules for the sole purpose of allowing the use of paper ballots to act upon 12 pieces of legislation that would enable the church to effectively continue its work until the postponed 2020 General Conference is held in 2022. While other potential amendments were considered, it was agreed that these 12 pieces of legislation would enable the church to continue its administrative functions appropriately.

Meeting held at the church at 1:00 pm with 4 members present: Liz Dempsey, Jerry Vaughn, Pastor Paul Messmer, Cheri Bingham.

Pastor Paul started the meeting with prayer.

Old business for discussion & follow up:

Quarterly schedule (Jan-March) and UMCOR Sunday

Odanah Native American church – received message from Carla that the check sent had not been cashed. Liz contacted Micheal John Reszler & they have had a problem with the handling of some mail that comes to the church. He sent his home address & requested we sent any correspondence to that address. Carla will reissue our check to them. We also briefly discussed finding out if they have specific needs that we could help with rather than just a cash donation.

New envelopes and pew cards have been received for the Special Sunday offerings. List given to committee members of where funds for each Special Sunday offering goes/what it supports.

School collection for urgent needs of Lake Holcombe students– Liz contacted the school & they have several needs for the students. They suggested a cash donation & let them purchase their needs. We did this in the fall but committee members felt they & the congregation would prefer a listing of specific items & allow the members to purchase the items. This was our method prior to the pandemic & was well supported by the congregation.

Camp scholarships – There is \$838.20 in the camp scholarship fund to help provide funding for students/families to attend one of our state UMC camps. The conference does not plan to publish books this year but information about the camps & the schedule is available online. All registration will be done online this year. There is additional information at the conference camp website: **wiumcamps.org**. We will be planning to promote camp attendance in the spring.

Christmas gifts for the college students- have received feedback from a couple students, and one gift has not yet been delivered. We mailed that one out for a third time & hopefully the student receives it!

Care-Net fund drive has ended (one bottle still not returned?) Carla may send them a check for the amount collected. We will be returning the bottles to their agency soon.

New business:

Received a 'Thank-You" from Temba Nkomozepi, the missionary that Holcombe UMC supports at Mujila Falls. He will begin regular correspondence & send the church a quarterly newsletter. They can also be followed on Facebook @ Mujila Falls Agriculture Centre.

Ingathering 2021 – Annual Conference will be June 18 – 19, 2021. It will be held virtually again this year. Each district has designated pick-up and drop-off sites. All donations must be dropped off at one of the designated sites for our district between **Monday, June 14<sup>th</sup> and Monday, June 21<sup>st</sup>.** All churches are encouraged to begin collecting for the <u>Personal Dignity Kits and the Homecare Kits</u>. We will soon post a list and have a container available for the collection. Items may be put together in a kit, or they may be donated separately. We briefly discussed support for the Holcombe Prom, being held without support of the school this year. Decision made to send this to the Ad Board meeting next week, since we currently do not have undesignated funds for this in Missions account.
