POP-UP HOUSE BOOK

You Will Need: (underline indicates direction of paper grain)


House structure: 1 piece heavy white drawing paper: 16" x 8"

Signature sheets: 3 pieces medium white drawing paper: 7 1/2" x 4"

Cutting template


12" white waxed thread and large needle

Small black binder-clip



To Build House:

- 1. Use template to trace and cut lines with x-acto blade. Place on table with left curve smiling, right curve frowning. With pencil, mark upper left corner with "x" and lower right with "o".
- 2. Turn over so that "x" is face down. Accordion fold into four panels. Unfold.
- 3. With "x" face down, fold lengthwise in half (don't fold roof points or curves).
- 4. Push ends towards center until house pops open.
- 5. Keep pushing to fold into booklet and bring "x" around to become front cover. To open, pull on curved pages. Display with house at 90-degree angles.



To Add Signature:

- 6. Fold text pages in half and stack together.
 Place pages into centermost fold, next to the "o" (marked with 3 holes in figure 4 above). Clip securely to single layer of house only. Punch 3 holes through pages and single layer of house.
- 7. Thread needle and sew pages to house using **3-hole pamphlet stitch:**

Start from the bottom. Push thread up through center-hole B. Go down through hole A. Bring thread up through hole C. Push thread down again through hole B. Make sure two tails are on opposite sides of long thread (running between hole A and hole C). Pull snug. Tie square knot. Trim ends to 1/2".
