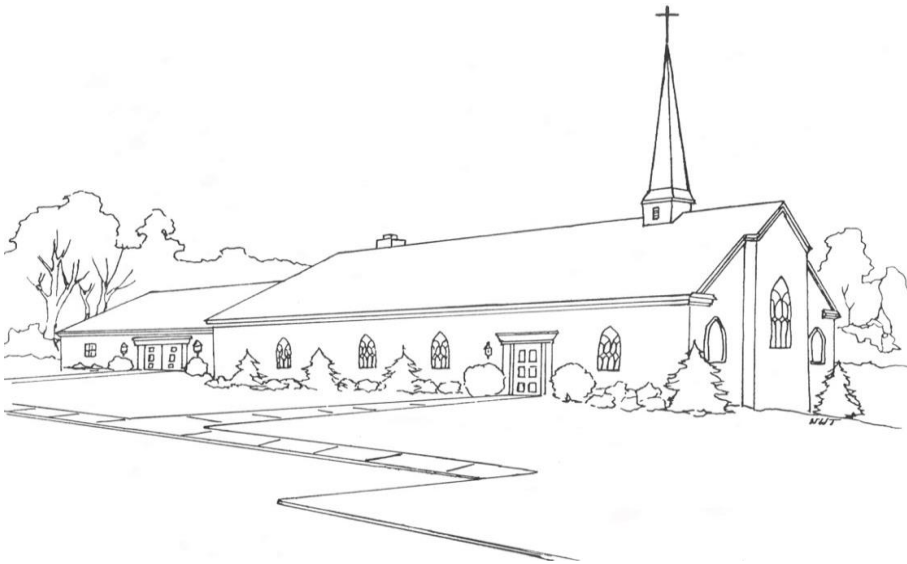

## Scripture Passage [2 Corinthians 6:4-10, NRSV]

- <sup>4</sup> But as servants of God we have commended ourselves in every way: through great endurance, in afflictions, hardships, calamities,  
<sup>5</sup> beatings, imprisonments, riots, labors, sleepless nights, hunger;  
<sup>6</sup> by purity, knowledge, patience, kindness, holiness of spirit, genuine love,  
<sup>7</sup> truthful speech, and the power of God; with the weapons of righteousness for the right hand and for the left;  
<sup>8</sup> in honor and dishonor, in ill repute and good repute. We are treated as impostors, and yet are true;
