Arches National Park, Utah


Thurs. Oct 20, 2022. It was worth getting up at 4:30am to be sure of a place in line to enter Arches. Everyone said the place is "Memorable"...

We will always remember the Ute Museum in Montrose, CO.


Gregg Deal is a husband, father, member of the **Pyramid Lake Paiute** Tribe, artist and activist. As a provocative contemporary artist-activist, much of Deal's work centers around Indigenous identity and pop culture, touching on issues of race relations, historical consideration and stereotype.

Another requested recipe was the **Stuffed Peaches** provided by Anne Nichols.

Ingredients

- 6 peaches, halved and pitted
- ¼ cup butter, melted
- 3 tablespoon cinnamon-sugar*
- 4 ounce package cream cheese, softened
- ¼ cup sugar
- 1 egg yolk
 - 1 ½ teaspoon vanilla

Directions



2. In a medium mixing bowl beat cream cheese with a mixer on medium speed until smooth. Add sugar, egg yolk, and vanilla. Beat until combined. Spoon cream cheese mixture into peach centers.

3. Bake, uncovered, about 30 minutes or until lightly browned and softened. Serve warm or at room temperature.



Journey Planning for 2024

Each normal year (not Covid) FFI asks all clubs, domestic and international, to fill out a survey of Inbound and Outbound journey information. How many ambassadors you can support, how many inbound journeys you will receive, and what months are best are examples of the information requested. FFI also wants to know about outbound journeys: how many journeys we want to take, where our club wants to go, and what months do we want to travel?

This information, once received from all clubs, is used by FFI to perform a Matching exercise, and all clubs are notified of assigned inbound and outbound journeys. This process is started in November and completed in April for the year two years ahead. We will be participating in this process in November for the year 2024.

All members will have an opportunity to make their suggestions as soon as I figure out an equitable way to do that. Be thinking about what location(s) we should request. Watch this space!


