

*** CONFESSION AND FORGIVENESS**

All may make the sign of the cross, the sign marked at baptism...

The congregation may respond with facemasks on:

C: Amen.

*** CONFESSION AND FORGIVENESS**

P: Almighty God, to whom all hearts are open, all desires known, and from whom no secrets are hid: Cleanse the thoughts of our hearts by the inspiration of your Holy Spirit, that we may perfectly love you and worthily magnify your holy name, through Jesus Christ our Lord.

The congregation may respond with facemasks on:

C: Amen.

*** CONFESSION AND FORGIVENESS**

P: If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. But if we confess our sins, God who is faithful and just will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Silence for reflection and self-examination.

*** CONFESSION AND FORGIVENESS** P: Most merciful God, The congregation may respond with facemasks on: C: we confess that we are in bondage to sin and cannot free ourselves. We have sinned against you in thought, word, and deed, by what we have done and by what we have left undone. We have not loved you with our whole heart; we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves.

*** CONFESSION AND FORGIVENESS** The congregation may respond with facemasks on: C: For the sake of your Son, Jesus Christ, have mercy on us. Forgive us, renew us, and lead us, so that we may delight in your will and walk in your ways, to the glory of your holy name. Amen

*** CONFESSION AND FORGIVENESS** P: Almighty God, in his mercy, has given his Son to die for us and, for his sake, forgives us all our sins. As a called and ordained minister of the Church of Christ, and by his authority, I therefore declare to you the entire forgiveness of all your sins, in the name of the Father, and of the + Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

The congregation may respond with facemasks on:


- A: In peace let us pray to the Lord.

P: The Lord be with you.

The congregation may respond with facemasks on:

*** GOSPEL ANNUNCIATION**

P: The Gospel according to Saint Luke the 24th Chapter.

C: Glory to you O Lord! (Spoken)

¹On the first day of the week, at early dawn, [the women] came to the tomb, taking the spices that they had prepared. ²They found the stone rolled away from the tomb, ³but when they went in, they did not find the body. ⁴While they were perplexed about this, suddenly two men in dazzling clothes stood beside them.

⁵The women were terrified and bowed their faces to the ground, but the men said to them, "Why do you look for the living among the dead? He is not here, but has risen. ⁶Remember how he told you, while he was still in Galilee, ⁷that the Son of Man must be handed over to sinners, and be crucified, and on the third day rise again."

⁸Then they remembered his words, ⁹and returning from the tomb, they told all this to the eleven and to all the rest. ¹⁰Now it was Mary Magdalene, Joanna, Mary the mother of James, and the other women with them who told this to the apostles. ¹¹But these words seemed to them an idle tale, and they did not believe them.


¹²But Peter got up and ran to the tomb; stooping and looking in, he saw the linen cloths by themselves; then he went home, amazed at what had happened.

The congregation may respond with facemasks on:


C: Praise To You, O Christ (Spoken)

Live Streaming Church







The congregation may respond with facemasks on:

C: We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen.

The congregation may respond with facemasks on:

C: We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, of one Being with the Father.

The congregation may respond with facemasks on:

C: Through him all things were made. For us and for our salvation he came down from heaven; by the power of the Holy Spirit he became incarnate from the virgin Mary, and was made man. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate;

The congregation may respond with facemasks on:

C: he suffered death and was buried. On the third day he rose again in accordance with the Scriptures; he ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead, and his kingdom will have no end.

The congregation may respond with facemasks on:

C: We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son. With the Father and the Son he is worshiped and glorified. He has spoken through the prophets. We believe in one holy catholic and apostolic Church.

* NICENE CREED

The congregation may respond with facemasks on:

C: We acknowledge one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins. We look for the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come. Amen.

*** PRAYERS OF INTERCESSION**

Each petition will end with the words, A: Risen Lord.

The congregation may respond with facemasks on:

C: Your mercy is great.

*** PRAYERS OF INTERCESSION**

The prayer concludes...

P: Incline your ear to our prayers and fill us with power to begin living out our faith, by the power of your Son our savior, Jesus Christ. Amen.

C: Amen.


*** SHARING OF THE PEACE**

P: Holy, living, and loving God...

P: With joy we come again to your feast of redemption, glad to receive your gifts of grace for the strengthening of our spirits. Let us celebrate our Lord's resurrection and come to his holy supper!

The congregation may respond with facemasks on:


C: Amen.
