And the Troubles: "It was less unusual for clerics to sympathise with republicans than many think. It was not uncommon for young men from Belfast, Derry, Newry or South Armagh to enter the priesthood while one of their siblings or cousins was joining the IRA. At the same time as my cousin Stephen was entering the Redemptorist order, three of his brothers were incarcerated in Long Kesh. During the 1981 hunger strike Fr Brian McCreesh, brother of Raymond, an IRA volunteer who died after 61 days without food, said his brother was not a criminal but a political prisoner." We live on an interesting island!
