Session I will be held from 9:00 to 11:30 a.m. Monday-Friday.

Session II will be held from 9:00 to 11:00 a.m. Monday-Friday.

(This is a free camp, sponsored by Hondo Art League. Registration time-frame—May 18*-June 7)

NOTE: Covid precautions and safe camp guidelines will be followed, including required mask wearing by students and teachers and hand sanitizing after each class.

PARENTS, PLEASE NOTE: **UNLESS AN ILLNESS OR EMERGENCY OCCURS, STUDENTS MUST COMMIT TO ALL 5 DAYS OF CAMP.** STUDENTS CANNOT ATTEND SOME DAYS AND THEN GO OUT OF TOWN, ETC. This situation keeps others who would commit to 5 days from attending. Art projects will be incomplete unless students are at camp M-F of their week.

Registration forms accepted NO EARLIER THAN ***May 18** AND NO LATER THAN **June 7**, but the camp registration *may* be closed earlier than June 7 (if all classes are full). **Registration is by mail on a first come, first served basis.** Mail form to **S. Who can register? **Program is for 2021-2022, next year's, Grades 3-12** (in grades 2-11 this year--2020-2021).

WHEN?? **Session I—grades 3-5: July 12-16 (Monday-Friday), 9:00 a.m. - 11:30 a.m. each day.** **Session II—grades 6-12: July 19-23 (Monday-Friday), 9:00-11:00 a.m. each day.** Note—**Both sessions: On the first day of camp--be there at 8:30; on Friday of each session--9:00-11:30--Art Display from 11:30-12:00.**

Where?? Hondo Art League Building at 820 Harper Rd. and Vandenberg Rd.--ACROSS FROM the S. TX. REGIONAL AIRPORT, west of Rick Taylor Rec Center.

What is the camp about? The students will participate (have hands-on experience) in 4 different art forms, and an art piece will be created in each form.

- 6) providing enrichment and growth opportunities: instruction in a number of art forms, personal growth and esteem-boosting possibilities through product completion, additional esteem-boosting opportunities through caring teachers’ guidance, and enhancement of social skills through interaction with other art students.

Session I classes, grades 3,4, and 5, *may* include: Acrylics, Painted bird houses, paper art: quilling, and an arts/crafts project

Session II classes, grades 6-12, *may* include – watercolor, Pastel Art, possibly sculpture, one other medium
