Show Rules

- Exhibitors and visitors will be required to comply with the NSW government Covid 19 rules at the time of the show and the club's Covid 19 plan.
- The Mudgee Poultry and Pigeon Club Inc. will run the show in accordance with the rules and regulations of the EPA of NSW and local club rules.
- All exhibits are to be the bona-fide property of the exhibitor and any attempt to fake or misrepresent will result in disqualification.
- Any breed that isn't in the Australian Standard will be judged under the British Standard or American Standard.
- Unhealthy or vermin infected birds will be removed from the pavilion at the owner's risk.
- Birds will not be allowed to be handled without the permission of the stewards.
- Judging will be open and anyone acting unfavorably will be asked to leave the pavilion.
- Judges decisions will be final and will not be debated.
- The judge will have the right to award "Champion of Breed" at his/her discretion
- Spurs are to be trimmed and if not, the Judge reserves the right not to handle the bird.
- The executive reserves the right to refuse any entry without giving a reason.
- Exhibits in breed trios or pairs are not eligible for individual major awards other than Champion Pairs.
- Juniors to be 16 years or younger and must pen their own exhibits.
- Once a junior has won 3 Best Junior awards they must show in open classes.
- All care will be taken; however, the club will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury that may arise from any cause to persons and exhibits.
- All eggs are the property of the club.
- A separate Class will be made if 6 or more of the same colour or variety are entered in AORC/ARC/AOV.

Penning and Unpenning

- Penning will be from 3pm to 6.30pm on the Friday and from 7am to 8.30am on the Saturday.
- Pen numbers will be provided to the exhibitor on arrival at the pavilion.
- Judging to start at 9am sharp on the Saturday.
- All temporary leg rings are asked to be removed upon penning.
- No birds will be accepted after judging has commenced.
- All exhibitors must be accompanied by a steward when unpenning.
- Unpenning priority will be given to visitors who have travelled long distances.
- Anyone staying Saturday night may leave their birds in the Pavilion and pick them up Sunday with prior approval of the Show Secretary.
