Exciting Tres Dias news...Kairos Outside Eastern Wisconsin Weekend #1 is here!!

Thanks be to God. A special Tres Dias for women affected by prison called Kairos has been blessed.

We wondered if we could find volunteers and they answered God's call.

We had little hope of finding candidates that would want to attend a 3 day weekend and had been affected by prison. We have a miraculous 25 applications.

Kairos Outside Eastern Wisconsin #1 will be Friday, November 13 to Sunday, November 15 Camp Lucerne- W6460 County Road YY. Neshkoro, WI 54960. Lake Lucerne is located five miles south of Wautoma off of Highway 73. Turn east on County Highway YY and proceed a half-mile to the main camp entrance.

Saturday night, November 14, there is a Walking in Love service and 4th day members are welcome to line the walkway as the candidates move to the chapel. Please be there by 8:00.

You are welcome to attend the closing on Sunday, November 15th. Please be at the camp at 2:00. Kairos does not have Eucharists, we can call this a closing ceremony at 2:30 pm. At least, pray for us.
