Thank you for your interest in our organization. The Indianhead Rifle and Pistol Club (*IRPC*) was chartered in 1983. The range is located on 100 acres (*leased from the City of Spooner*) one and a half miles East of US 53/63 on County Highway A. We have a beautiful Club House used for our monthly meetings and special events. It's also available for private events or classes (*fees, advance reservations and membership vote required*). We are a **NONPROFIT** group relying on fund raisers and donations to for range maintenance and construction costs.

Most ranges have covered shooting stations, swinging or moveable targets and backboards. We proudly support Law Enforcement groups in our County and State. Wisconsin State Patrol, Washburn County Sheriff's Department, Spooner Police Department, NRA, etc. use our facility for training, qualifications and practice.

IRPC partners with Safari Club, Ducks Unlimited and Whitetails Unlimited (*among others*) supporting our County Youth Groups such as Hunter's Safety (*through the DNR*), Archery and Shooting Events (*through 4-H*) and Spooner High School Trap Team. Additionally, we sponsor several Annual events (*free to the public*) including Spring Gun Show, Family Rang Day, Public Sight-in Days, and various safety and CCW classes.

The Range is available the entire year to Club Members and up to 4 Guests (*accompanied by member at all times*). Entrance to the facility is by combination access changed annually. Advance notice of all Range closures (*maintenance/special events*) will be provided all to members.

IRPC Range Rules

- 1. You must shoot directly down range into a berm. <u>ABSOLUTELY NO FIRING ACROSS RANGE</u> <u>AT ANYTIME.</u>
- 2. Never place targets on the ground in front of berms **this results in ricochets ONLY** place targets at the foot of the berm. Think **safety** first, we have neighbors to think about.
- 3. Do not attach targets to or in front of wooden uprights. Targets are to be attached to the provided backboards or chicken wire **ONLY** No plastic or glass targets permitted on any IRPC Range.
- 4. Practice "<u>pack-it-in/pack-it-out</u>" courtesy. If you bring targets or other disposable items, such as empty ammunition boxes or food containers, please pick them up and put them in provided trash containers or take them home with you when you leave.
- 5. Do not use high power rifles to shoot gongs on the pistol ranges. High power rifles destroy the metal gongs and ruins the range for others to use.
- 6. Nothing larger than .22 rim fire ammunition is allowed on the .22 Range.
- 7. Range gate <u>must be locked</u> when entering or leaving the range. If you are using the range and there are several different vehicles, please designate a person to ensure gate is secure do not assume someone else will lock the gate.
- 8. Shooting further than 300 yards is **NOT ALLOWED** without permission **AND** only by experienced marksmen.
- 9. Members may bring up to four (4) guests to the IRPC Range. Guests must be accompanied by a member **AT ALL TIMES**.
- 10. No alcoholic beverages are to be consumed until you are finished shooting.
- 11. **ABSOLUTELY** no alcoholic beverages allowed on firing lines at any time.
- 12. No organized "Group Use" of IRPC range without prior permission.
- 13. **ABSOLUTELY** no "Actual" or "Simulated" automatic shooting allowed at any time.
- 14. All members and their guests must comply with IRPC's posted rules. Non-compliance will result in expulsion from the range, membership revoked and you will not be allowed to rejoin.

Members and guests must handle themselves in a **SAFE** and **COURTEOUS** manner while using the range. Please be aware of your surroundings and neighbors while using the range. This club belongs to all of us. Report any infractions to a club officer (*numbers posted on club bulletin boards*) or in the event of an immediate threat or danger dial 911. Looking the other way is not a resolution.
