

2022 EAHA Youth Club Rules

- 1) All EAHA rules apply to the EAHA Youth Club.
- 2) The youth must be a member of the EAHA Youth Club to earn points. Annual membership dues must be paid to be eligible for year-end awards from the EAHA Youth Club. Points will not begin to accrue until dues are paid.
- 3) To qualify for a high point or reserve award:
 - the youth must show the same horse a minimum of eight (8) times in at least one qualifying class
 - the youth's 8 qualifying shows must include at least **2** of the 4 EAHA Youth Club Shows (The 2022 Youth Club show dates are: 04/09/2022, 05/21/2022, 05/21/2022, 07/30/2022)
- 4) To qualify for a participation award:
 - the youth must show the same horse a minimum of eight (8) times in any one class; all classes qualify a youth for a participation award
 - the youth's 8 qualifying shows must include at least **1** of the 4 EAHA Youth Club shows (The 2022 Youth Club show dates are: 04/09/2022, 05/21/2022, 05/21/2022, 07/30/2022)
- 5) Points will be awarded in accordance with the EAHA points rule. Points from classes not shown in at least eight (8) times will not count.
- 6) Points will be kept on a one horse – one rider combination ONLY.
- 7) If a member wins more than one (1) EAHA Youth Club high point award during the show season, they will be awarded the high point award item (saddle/halter) in the category that they earned the highest points. For subsequent high point awards by the same member, a buckle will be awarded.
- 8) No youth may show a stallion.
- 9) No substitution of horses will be allowed.
- 10) Saddles will be awarded in all riding categories, except as noted in rule 7, if there are sufficient funds to purchase saddles. EAHA Youth Club will pay the cost of a basic saddle. Parents may be allowed to request a different style of saddle and may be allowed to customize the saddle at his/her own expense. More information at the end of the show season. The gaited saddle winner may request a gaited saddle or a western saddle.
