- **From The Kentucky Horse Park,** turn right when leaving the Horse Park on Iron Works Pike (KY-1973), turn right on Georgetown Road Route 25 then left on Iron Works Road (KY-1973) turn left on North Yarnallton Road and follow over I-64. You will see a Pine Knoll sign on the right past the Vinery entrance on the left curve.
