
Rev. Joe Kovach is coming to St George on April 30th to meet with the leadership and our CSL community.



Teen groups flying in should plan to land in Portland Airport (PDX). We are working to coordinate airport transportation (vans) for the 45-minute ride to the campground, but larger groups may want to coordinate their own transportation.

Please note: The dates are Wednesday-to-Wednesday instead of our typical Saturday-to-Saturday on a one-time basis. CSL is in the process of purchasing this camp, but Summer 2022 was already booked by other groups. July 6 to July 13 is the only remaining slot available for an in-person experience this year.
