Council of the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32 held their regular meeting of Council on Thursday, July 11, 2019 in the Municipal Office in the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32, Saskatchewan with all councillors present.

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. with Reeve Arthur presiding.

Minutes of the Regular Meeting held on June 13th, 2019 were approved as circulated, the Statements of Financial Activities for the month of June were accepted as presented and the accounts were passed and approved for payment.
