

DYSFUNTIONAL PERSON – Parent or spouse. Can be a "workaholic," mentally or physically disabled, alcoholic.

SUPER HERO - Usually the oldest child. Taught by the ENABLER to "care take." Role in family – to bring pride/honor.

ENABLER - Usually the spouse of the DYSFUNCTIONAL PERSON.

BABY or CLOWN – This person's role is to divert the tension.

LOST CHILD - Lost in something other than family dynamics: books, music, pet, or may literally leave. Withdraws from family.

SPACEGOAT - takes focus off the real problem.

***SUPER HEROS grow up and marry a SCAPE GOAT (& vice versa.) One of them may then become the ENABLER & the other the DYSFUNCTIONAL PERSON.

DYSFUNTIONAL FAMILY RULES:

- 1. Don't talk.
- 2. Don't trust.
- 3. Don't feel.

These rules keep people locked into their role.
