COFFEE & COOKIES: We are asking for purchased cookies due to Covid, hopefully we can go back to the wonderful homemade we used to have soon. Please sign the sheet in the Narthex if you are able to provide cookies.

FURNACE REPLACEMENT: The Church furnaces have been replaced. This was approved at our 2021 Congregational Meeting with time to be determined by Council. The furnaces were working at that time but had needed repairs. Several weeks ago one furnace quit working and was not repairable. The other was determined to be in bad shape and had had a small creosote fire. So council, based on the 2021 approval, contracted Griffiths Mechanical to replace them. They also replaced the air conditioner which had been approved in 2021, since it cost less to do them together.

COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS: We continue to request that, out of respect for the safety of others in the community, if you are not vaccinated, please wear a mask at all times in the buildings. For those that are fully vaccinated, masks are optional if the county's test positivity rate falls below 10%. If the rate is 10% or above, masks are required for everyone. Pastor will continually monitor the situation.
