The 36th Annual Assembly...A Vision in the Making

Now let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds, not forsaking our assembling together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near. Hebrews 10:24:25

Planning for the 36th Annual Assembly started with a vision--for the first time in Tres Dias History, delegates from all chartered communities worldwide would gather together in one place to praise the Lord. And even if attendance at the Assembly, scheduled for July 12-14, falls a few communities short of this ambitious goal, it is still likely to be a landmark event.

Abundant Life Tres Dias and Northern Illinois Tres Dias will co-host the event. Planning started last November, when Tom Miller of Abundant Life Tres Dias sent letters to leaders of all communities worldwide announcing the Assembly and setting the 100 percent challenge in motion. The Assembly theme, from Hebrews 10: 24:25, is "Encourage each other." Building on the theme, the letter asked each community to partner with another community to encourage that community to attend. The letter also included a response card, asking if the community planned to send a delegate, and if not, why not. If a community indicates that finances prevent sending a delegate, the Abundant Life team hopes to pair that community up with another community that can offer support.

Generally, between 30 to 40 communities send delegates to an Assembly. The planning committee is giving special attention to the 39 communities that seldom send, or have never sent, a delegate. Each of these communities has now been assigned a "prayer warrior," a volunteer from the host communities who will pray for their assigned community and reach out, personally, to offer support and encouragement.

In addition, individuals who have been associated with the startups of foreign communities are serving as liaisons to encourage attendance. If with all this effort, the community cannot send a delegate, the community will be asked to appoint a representative to carry the community banner.

The host communities have asked for responses by the end February. If your community has not yet responded, the hosts ask that you please do so by the requested date.

If you have not yet contacted another community and encouraged them to attend, put this item on the agenda for your next secretariat meeting and select a community to encourage.
