Dear brothers and sisters,

The Responsorial Psalm of this Sunday repeats "Taste and see the goodness of the Lord". It is an incredible expression of joy and trustfulness. We live in a society that seems to maximize and profit on bad news and keeping us scared. It is not anymore just to let you the news but to scare you and show you how bad the world is. In the midst of all those bad news, come a Good News, I will say an "excellent" news – Christ has not quit on us. He offers Himself as food to satisfy our hunger and to calm our fears.
