If you are ever faced with this situation, and we really hope that you aren't, here is a list of things you should do...

**1**

Contact your local Dog Warden. This information can be found on your local council website

**2**

Contact your dog's chip company and let them know your dog is missing

**3**

Register your dog missing on here [www.doglost.co.uk](http://www.doglost.co.uk)

**4**

Ring all local veterinary practices in case your dog has been handed in

**5**

Leave all practices with your contact details and details of your dog in case they are taken in at a later stage

**6**

Social media post on your local social media pages

**7**

Contact local rescues & kennels in case your dog has been taken to and handed into any of them

**8**

If you think your dog has been stolen, contact the police

**9**

Put up posters of your missing dog
