• Joshua 18:10

# **ANSWER - SHILOH here in Genesis 49 IS A REFERENCE/NAME GIVEN TO THE LORD JESUS**

- v. 9 Many references to Judah and a "lion"
  - o Hebrews 7:14 (see genealogies in Matthew 1:1-6; Luke 3:23-34)
  - o Revelation 5:5

- <u>v. 10 –</u>
  - o "...sceptre shall not depart from Judah..."
    - > A symbol of a king and his kingdom
      - ☐ Matthew 2:1-2
      - ☐ I Timothy 6:15
      - ☐ Isaiah 9:7
  - o <u>"...Shiloh..."</u>
    - ➤ "SENT" Matthew 15:22-24
    - ➤ "PEACEFUL ONE" Isaiah 9:6; Isaiah 53:5; Ephesians 2:14-18; Colossians 1:20-21
