- I know that the bible says that God rewards fools and transgressors but it doesn't mean that. (Prov 26:10)
- I know the Bible seems to clearly say that Paul was robbing churches but it doesn't mean that. (2 Cor 11:8)
- I know that the Bible now clearly teaches that that you can sacrifice reptiles to God but it doesn't mean that (Lev 12:8 KJV)
- I know the Bible says that men are sleeping together and women are grinding but it doesn't in any way give the impression that they are having gay sex.
 - And an article called *Luke's Gay Apocalypse* uses these twisted passages to draw the conclusion that you can be gay and still be raptured. (Luke 17:34 KJV)
- I know that the bible speaks of gentiles sucking the breasts of Kings and nursing fathers but it doesn't mean that. (Num 11:12 KJV / Isaiah 60:16 (Most translations))
- I know it seems like there are female angles in the bible but it doesn't mean that (Zechariah 5:9)

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- I know that it sounds like God himself is masturbating and that he's shaving women's vaginas and He is discovering their vaginas and stripping them naked but it doesn't mean that. (Isaiah 27:12 ASV / Isaiah 7:20 NAS / Isaiah 3:17 KJV)
- I know the bible is full of unicorns, people pissing all over the place, people eating their own dung and drinking their own piss, Paul is going to the tavern, Daniel is a president, Peter is running around naked, they're celebrating Easter in the book of Acts but these things are very familiar to me and have always been in the bible.

 - Eating their own dung Isaiah 36:12

 - Peter running naked (John 21:7)
- I know that crazy 1611 KJV has some funny words like;
- Aliens, worlds, planets, shuttle, woof, ouches, napkin, pillow, shipmen, sailors, navy, munitions, concord, pavilion, theatre, parched corn, Wimples, looking glass, glasses, fashion, gay clothing, Girdles, bonnets, aprons, needlework, Insurrection, senate, presidents, pence, bank, tires, brakes, mufflers, ornaments, Passengers, coupling, sporting, sport, porters, gross, scum, slime, wizards, subscribe, publish, media, press, pen, advertise, merchandise, accounting, science, Jupiter, gravity, space, penny... matrix, bottles, couch, stuff, engines, planes, pilots, ferry boat, college, townclerk, doctors, lawyers, silly, pollute, environ, round about, street, apes, peacock, garlick, traffick, castle, damsel, unicorn, dwarf, satyr....

But those have always been in the Cambridge 1611 version and all KJV versions of the bible that followed but no one has ever thought that was odd until now

I know the KJV has so many punctuation, grammatical and spelling errors on every page that it looks like it was written by a 5th grader but that's just the way the King James language is written and it's always been like that

- Example: Num 11:13 Whence should I have flesh to give unto all this people? for they weep unto me, saying, Give us flesh, that we may eat.
- I know the KJV says Jesus has "paps" which means female breasts according to the original language (mastos) but it doesn't mean that
- I know it seems that even though Johnathan stripped naked in front of David, (1 Sam 18:3) David is described as falling on him in passion, he's bowing down with Johnathan which is a euphuism for sex in Job (Job 31:9) they're kissing each other they're weeping together, declaring their love for one another, and finally we have the term

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“until David exceeded” which means that he “grew large in His body” but it doesn’t mean that there was anything sordid going on....just move along (1 Sam 20:41)

- I know that every single pastor in the entire world will tell you “Lion” if you asked them “who laid down with the lamb” but they’re all just misremembering....all of them....every time....without exception. That’s completely understandable!
- I know that the phrase Judge not “lest” ye be judged is on the lips of every sinner you ever witnessed to, its quoted in a thousand books, movies and sermons, its probably repeated more than any other scripture in the biblebut in this timeline... it has never existed in any translation going all the way back to the dead sea scrolls.....NEVER EXISTED! So how did so many people get it wrong? To explain this, pastors tell me that someone probably preached a message 70 years ago and misquoted it and so that misquote went around the world like the telephone game somehow overcoming the influence of every bible and all the people reading and studying those bibles. I don’t really think that’s possible do you? So if its not that....what is your explanation?
- I know it says that
 - *“God created them male and female created he them; and blessed them, and called their name Adam, in the day when they were created”*. I know that sounds exactly like God just named them both Adam but it doesn’t mean that. (Gen 5:2)
- I know the bible calls Jesus a Holy Thing but its not degrading or blasphemous in any way (Luke 1:35 KJV)
- I know it says that one of the criteria to be an elder is that he is a “lover of good men” but there’s no inuendo there (Titus 1:8 KJV)
- I know the KJV translates a word which means **thoroughly** as **thoroughly** in some places and **thoroughly** in other places even though its supposed to mean the same thing and you would think it would be spelled the same way but that’s totally normal....right? (Exodus 21:19 vs Job 6:2 KJV only)
- Another example is how the Bible sometimes translates a word alway and other times its always but that’s totally normal right? (2 Sam 9:10 or 1 Chron 16:15)

- Noah is Noe
- Asher is Aser
- Hosea is Osee
- Nebuchadnezzar is nebuchadrezzer
- OT Judah lost his h
- NT Judah is now Judas

- John the Baptist is John Baptist
- Elijah is Elias
- John is Joses
- Isaiah is Esias
- Timothy is Timotheous
- Manasseh is Manasses
- Ephraim is Joseph
- Zebulun is Zebulon
- Boaz is Booz

I know the names of these 19 bible characters are not the same as what most people vividly remember the way they appear in our biblesand they're different from what you see in every book written about these characters...and everyone refers to them the way we all remember them but I guess people just aren't paying attention. That's just how they are spelled in the KJV when they are translated into English....and no one in the world ever noticed and the bibles have always spelled them that way.

I would not want to be the person responsible for caring for Gods sheep and have to find a way to defend and agree with this juggernaut of filth, blaspheme and confusion. This mountain of anomalies seems to be a high wall to scale if you are still trying to suggest that all this can be explained away with "misremembering".

I know that many of us that acknowledge this phenomenon have left the church for the following reason. Sunday after Sunday Pastors are misquoting the scripture real-time as they read from the bible because their memories are fighting them and they don't even realize their doing this. They have vivid memories of a passage being a certain way in their bible but now it reads differently and their conscience doesn't allow them to misquote it in a way that is

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different from their memory. But because they have a pet doctrine that the bible can't change, they subconsciously refuse to stop and rationally consider what is happening so they just gloss over the controversy and keep going as if nothing is wrong. The growing number of sheep in the congregation that are aware of this are noticing this egregious lack of discernment and our quickly losing trust in the pastor's ability to lead them. We assume if we can see these obvious changes then the pastor certainly should be able to see it. And when we go to you to alert you to this mysterious experience, we are often sharply dismissed as those that have lost our way with little honest discussion. This becomes the threshold of departure and we are forced to break fellowship.

Below is a list of what many believe are passages that have been supernaturally changed organized into category. If you try hard enough you can find some reasonable explanation in the commentaries for each and every one of these examples. But if you simply rely and trust in your memory you will certainly find that many of these are things that you have never noticed before. How is it possible for a Pastor to be in the ministry for 40 years and not know that the Wolf laid down with the lamb. How can a pastor of 40 years have never known that there is a passage in the book of Leviticus that indicates that you can sacrifice turtles. In other words....you can suggest that the terms Turtle dove and Turtle are interchangeable but it doesn't explain how a seasoned pastor could just be finding out now for the first time that this is in his bible. This is a man that has probably done several, 6-week series on the types and shadows of OT sacrifice during his ministry without ever learning that Leviticus 12:8 (KJV) has a translation that says "Turtles." Or today is the first time that he learned that God commanded the Israelites to sacrifice a "female" lamb or any of the bible quiz questions. These observations represent proof that is close to unequivocal. There is however just enough plausible deniability provided by Satan if you would prefer to choose to deny your screaming conscience and allow God to mess with your theology as he has done many times before.

Remember Rev 13:7 It was granted to him to make war with the saints and to overcome them. And authority was given him over every tribe, tongue, and nation. The devil doesn't have enough power to supernaturally change the bible unless God gives it to him.

Doctrinal Paradoxes

- **God has a father** - Rev 1:6 "And hath made us kings and priests unto God and his Father; to him be glory and dominion for ever and ever."
- **Slay them** Luke 19:27 "But those mine enemies, which would not that I should reign over them, bring hither, and slay them before me."

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- **Female Angels** Zechariah 5:9and looked, and, behold, there came out two women, and the wind was in their wings; for they had wings like the wings of a stork: and they lifted up the ephah between the earth and the heaven.
- **Sacrificing Female lambs**
- **Sacrificing turtles** Leviticus 12:6:8 And if she be not able to bring a lamb, then she shall bring two turtles, or two young pigeons; Leviticus 1:3 Your sacrifice must be without blemish
- **Jesus is a Holy thing** Luke 1:35 The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God.
- **Sin is condoned** Prov 26:10 KJV The great God that formed all things both rewardeth the fool, and rewardeth transgressors. 1 Pet 1:15 ... "Be holy, because I am holy."
- **Stealing condoned** 2 Cor 11:8 "I robbed other churches taking wages of them to do you service" Exodus 20:15 You shall not steal
- **There is no god** Isaiah 45:14 KJKVand they shall fall down unto thee, they shall make supplication unto thee, *saying*, Surely God *is* in thee; and *there is* none else, ***there is no God.***
- **Patriarchs using divination** But Laban said to him, "If I have found favor in your eyes, please stay. I have learned by divination that the LORD has blessed me because of you." (Gen 30:27 NIV, NAS)
- **Corn** Psalms 65:13 KJV Cambridge 1611"the valleys also are covered over with corn"
 - Corn was first used in the old world in 1630. Bible authors wouldn't of known about corn
- **Couch** Luke 5:24. But that ye may know that the Son of man hath power upon earth to forgive sins, (he said unto the sick of the palsy,) I say unto thee, Arise, and take up thy couch, and go into thine house. Cambridge 1611 says couch so its not a "modernization"
 - The word '**Couch**' appears to come from the French around the 1300's or perhaps from
 - Jay Wellington Couch who invented the couch in the year 1895. It wasn't invented when they published the 1611 KJV
 - Therefore...it is a biblical paradox for the word couch to be printed in a 1611 KJV bible.

- **Masturbation** Isaiah 27:12 "Jehovah will beat off His fruit" (American Standard Version ONLY)
- **Homosexuality** Luke 17:34 (KJV Only) I tell you, in that night there shall be two men in one bed; the one shall be taken, and the other shall be left. Two women shall be grinding together; the one shall be taken, and the other left.
- **Homosexuality** 1st Sam 18 / 20:41 David & Johnathan having gay sex (KJV) Rom 1:27 Homosexuality is forbidden
- **Cross dressing** Lev 8:13 KJV And Moses brought Aaron's sons, and put coats upon them, and girded them with girdles, and put bonnets upon them; as the LORD commanded Moses.

- **Shaving Women's Parts** Isaiah 7:20 ...the Lord will use a razor....to shave your heads and "private parts" = "Pudenda" = Female genitals (New International Version ONLY)
- **Jesus has female breasts like Baphomet** Revelations 1:13 (KJV Only) Son of man, clothed with a garment down to the foot, and girt about with the "paps" with a golden girdle. mas-tos; from the base of [G3145](#); a (properly, female) breast (as if kneaded up)
- **Peter is naked** John 21:7 KJV Therefore that disciple whom Jesus loved saith unto Peter, It is the Lord. Now when Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he girt his fisher's coat unto him, (for he was naked,) and did cast himself into the sea.

Cut and paste
