## **SUGGESTIONS FOR EASY CRAFTING WITH KIDS OF ALL AGES!**

You can make craft time more enjoyable for the younger children (and less stressful for yourself) by spending a little more time by preparing the components. Some suggestions include:

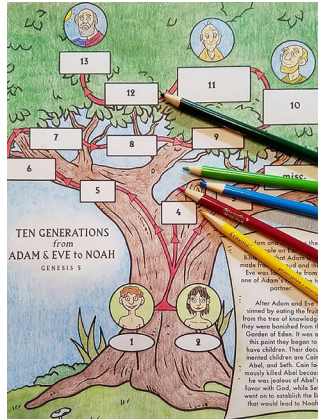
- Cut out the Names Cut-Out Page components beforehand and put them in plastic sandwich bags. Not only does it keep things organized, but you avoid having pieces go missing!
- Rather than cutting out the Names Cut-Out Page components beforehand, or having the younger kids struggle through it, print out the Complete Mock-Up Page as a coloring page!
- For kids who are cutting, place a few small trash cans or buckets around the room, and have the children sit in groups around them. That way, they can easily throw away their paper scraps as they go, leaving less cleanup for you after class!

# THE LINE OF KINGS until the BABYLONIAN INVASION 970 BC - 538 BC

1 CHRONICLES 3:10-16  
2 KINGS 24:6-7

As the kingship of Israel was passed down from father to son, these descendants of King Solomon were also the kings of the Bible! Israel broke off from Judah in 931 BC. Jesus' line comes from the kings of Judah (where Jerusalem was). This tree shows those kings.

The whole Bible story is about men being bad and God trying to win them back to being good. Just look at all the bad kings who led Judah into bad practices like idolatry—and the kings of Israel were worse! Only those with ☑ next to their names were good kings who did right!

God let the Assyrians and Babylonians invade Israel because the people were behaving badly.

Jechoniah, the primary ancestor in this tree, is the same Jehoiachin what tops Tree 9. It was common to have different name spellings in genealogies.

According to Matthew, there are 14 generations between Abraham and King David, 14 between King David and the Babylonian invasion, and 14 between the Babylonian invasion and Jesus.

The Babylonian invasion ended the Line of Kings. Most all citizens of Israel were exiled to Babylon, and Solomon's temple was destroyed. But accurate records were still kept, and this account follows Jesus' legal lineage back through his father Joseph.

There is another family tree in Luke, which most scholars believe traces Jesus' line through his mother Mary. She is not mentioned, but Joseph is. That's because it was unusual to them to mention a woman as a descendant.

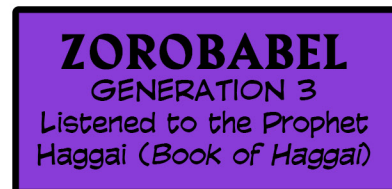
